

WEIRD ART BIZARRE PAINTINGS

HISTORY'S STRANGE FASCINATIONS

n 1746 a group of publishers approached Samuel Johnson with the idea of creating an authoritative dictionary of the English language. The Académie Française had already published their French Dictionnaire, which had taken 40 scholars 56 years to complete. Johnson said he could do it himself in three. So it took him eight, but it remains an astonishing achievement, and a fun read, when his irritability and wit ekes out in his definitions. Take the word dull: "adjective: Not exhilarating, not delightful. As, to make dictionaries is dull work."

I mention Dr Johnson because of a line he wrote in 1751: "Curiosity is the thirst of the soul," he said, explaining that it "makes us taste every thing with joy... by which it may be quenched." I grew up in a rare book shop. An old book with a great backstory is an effortless sale. Strange objects and strange stories fascinate us all.



It turns out that the same technique is useful for writing books, too. For years my favourite tidbit was something I'd read in the bookshop, in an 18th-century text on German hunting weaponry. In the mid-1600s, the German aristocracy would play a sport called 'fuchsprellen' before dinner. The word translates as 'fox-tossing'. Couples in an arena the size of a large tennis court would grip a long net slack on the ground between them. Animals were then released into the area – and



when one ran across the net, it was the couple's job to yank it taut, and catapult the creature into the air. This led to me writing a book on sports that were extinct, titled of course Fox Tossing, Octopus Wrestling and Other Forgotten Sports.

But in terms of curious visual matter, what better world is there to explore than the world of art? I started collecting stories and images years ago for The Madman's Gallery, a collection of history's strangest artworks, after being unable to find a book



on curiosities of art. Searching for bizarre paintings in art history is like looking for raindrops in the sea, but take the dealer's approach—sifting for great stories—and piece by piece, magnificently odd paintings and sculptures gather in this imaginary art gallery, in celebration of the depthless capacity and sheer variety of human creativity. The mystery of the nude Mona Lisa, the man who painted the sea floor, the werewolflegion of the Roman army, the New World art of 'angel musketeers', visions of the afterlife revealed by spirits, stolen art, revenge art, the giant panoramas that towered over Georgian London...

It is an impossible gallery, designed to slake, if only temporarily, the needs of a thirsty soul. I can see it in my head like a memory palace, and picture Dr Johnson there, holding court with other curiosity seekers in the gallery bar. Perhaps he would have taken to the Irish poet Louis MacNeice (1907-1963), who seems a kindred spirit. "World is crazier and more of it than we think..." MacNeice writes joyfully in his beautiful poem Snow, "The drunkenness of things being various." Edward Brooke-Hitching's The Madman's Gallery

THE HISTORY OF THE ART OF TATTOOING

t is believed that tattoos have been in existence since 12,000 BC, but there are some arguments regarding this matter. Tattooing has known to have been used for different purposes, varying from culture to culture, and also, from time to time, it has significantly changed in shapes, symbols, and sizes and place to place. though it is believed that tattoos undoubtedly came into existence much earlier. As the Pharaohs went on extending their empire, the concept of tattoos traveled with them, and Crete, Greece, Persia, and Arabia gained the skill and extended the art of tattooing. Tattooing spread to China around 2000 BC. Significant Use of Tattooing

While the Romans tattooed their criminals and slaves, the Greeks used tattoos for communication amongst spies. They marked their spies with tattoos which indicate their rank. This practice is still in vogue. The Ainu people, belonging to Western Asia, used tattoos to indicate the social status of their people. When girls came to age they were marked with special tattoo symbols and the married women as well. Japan got the knowledge of tattooing from the Ainu people, and the Japanese developed these to form symbols for their religious and ceremonial rites.

It is interesting to note that the tattoo designers in Borneo were women. This has been a cultural tradition of the Borneo people. The designs that were produced mainly belonged to the status of the person concerned and the tribe the person belonged to. While the Kayan woman would


have delicate tattoos on their arms which look like lacy gloves, the Dayak warriors would have tattoos according to their bravery. One who has "taken a head" would have tattoos on his hand. The Significance of Tattoos

Tattoos have always played a significant role in rituals and traditions. The women in Borneo wear tattoos on their fore-arm which indicate their skills, for example, a weaver, and this made her status as a prime marriageable subject. Tattoo markings around the wrists and fingers have been believed to ward off evil spirits, and others were used to signify the clan or society that people belonged to.

In present days tattoos have been designed by groups like the Hells Angels, which have been created to signify that particular group. It is believed that, the person wearing a tattoo is able to call the spirit associated with the tattoo that he is wearing. Even today this belief exists with people wearing images of tigers, snakes, and bird of prey, calling the ferocity of the spirit that each image represents.

The Good Nurse

ovie titles are important, but there's special significance to "The Good Nurse," based on the horrific killings of dozens and possibly hundreds of patients by a night nurse who injected fatal drugs into IV bags.

Real-life convicted killer Charles Cullen is not the "good nurse" in the title. It is, rather, fellow nurse Amy Loughren — played by Jessica Chastain — who first befriended Cullen, then suspected him, then helped bring him down.

In bravely securing evidence Loughren saved countless lives, because the hospitals where Cullen worked lacked the moral courage to act on suspicions — firing Cullen for minor offenses and leaving him to keep killing (he worked at nine hospitals.) Director Tobias Lindholm and screenwriter Krysty Wilson-Cairns, working from Charles Graeber's book, make a powerful argument for telling stories via those who confronted them. And so Loughren, a single working mom with heart trouble, becomes a superhero.

When you have a cast as talented as this, led by Chastain and Eddie Redmayne, it



becomes less important if the structure veers formulaic. There are, moments where "The Good Nurse" has a too-familiar TV police procedural feel. But the acting triumphs.

We begin with a prologue in 1999, at a Pennsylvania hospital. A patient "codes," and staff rush — unsuccessfully — to save him. Quietly watching is Cullen.

Redmayne plays Cullen as someone unremarkable. Taking to heart a description in Graeber's book of "a sad Mr. Rogers type," he even wears a gray cardigan. Lacking personality, he is a true cipher.



Now we jump to 2003, and a New Jersey hospital. Amy, the night nurse, is exhausted and overworked, but devoted to patients. When an elderly patient's husband balks at leaving his wife alone, Amy breaks the rules and brings him a blanket.

A single mom, Amy works nights so she can be with her kids in the day. She can barely pay the babysitter, let alone the doctor treating her heart condition, which will require surgery. She can't get care in the hospital because they'd fire her. And she needs several more months to qualify for health insurance.

Enter Cullen, who arrives on the night shift with "great recommendations." Seemingly generous and hard-working, he becomes friends with Amy, playing with her kids, and vowing to help conceal her condition. Meanwhile, Amy's elderly patient dies, inexplicably. Police start asking questions.

Two detectives have suspicions. Played by Nnamdi Asomugha and Noah Emmerich they are stonewalled by the hospital. Kim Dickens is chilling as a former nurse turned administrator.

As for Amy, she initially defends Charlie, but understands how he could have gamed the system. As more people die, she discovers his tampering. But the police need proof.

Chastain's best scenes come when she is seized with fear, yet determined to stop her friend. Redmayne shows us what truly mundane evil looks like. He displays a veneer starting to crack.

So we know whodunit, and we know how. But anyone looking for an answer as to WHY won't get it here. And to the filmmakers' credit, they don't manufacture a motivation where there wasn't one. There's no need. The unembellished horror of this real-life tale is way more than enough.

My Policeman

ven if you've never been to a Harry Styles concert, it's hardly difficult to comprehend his huge appeal.

Also huge, to his many fans: the news of Styles starring in a movie. (Or, did you happen to miss the circus surrounding "Don't Worry Darling"?)

But "huge" is not the word to describe Styles' performance in "My Policeman," a deliberately paced, melancholy period piece about love, loss, pain, prejudice and the danger of living inauthentically. The biggest challenge for Styles, as one of a six-actor ensemble is to mute the confident pop-star magnetism, in service of the story. This he does. At times, though, it seems he's pressing too hard on that mute button.

To be fair, much of this may stem from choices by director Michael Grandage and screenwriter Ron Nyswaner, who fashion Styles' character, Tom, a working-class policeman who hides his gay relationship while in a heterosexual marriage, as a blank canvas onto whom others project desires. There's been criticism that Styles gives an underdeveloped performance, but that ignores the fact that his very character IS underdeveloped. How can we know him if he does not know himself?

Still, it's a striking contrast with a sharply drawn portrayal like that of David Dawson as Patrick, Tom's lover. Or that of Rupert Everett, who plays older Patrick in the aftermath of a serious stroke.

The film is based on the novel by Bethan Roberts, who was inspired by the life of British novelist E.M. Forster and his love triangle with a London police officer and the officer's wife. From this, Roberts fashioned a 1950s-based story about a similar trio but with a devastating, terrible twist: It was a crime for men to have sex with each other in England until 1967.



We begin in the 1990s (the movie will toggle back and forth between two eras) with Marion (Gina McKee), inviting Patrick to recover at her home rather than in a depressing care home. Her Itusband, Tom (Linus Roache) is furious. Tom orders her to send Patrick away, but she refuses.

Now we flash back, with the younger Tom (Styles), soft-spoken but handsome, wooing Marion (Emma Corrin) by teaching her how to swim. It's a chaste courtship. One day Tom invites Marion, a schoolteacher who loves art, to a private gallery tour, courtesy of a curator he's met. This young curator is Patrick, and he's all the things Tom isn't: intellectual, worldly, highly cultured. But Marion remains attracted to Tom. And Tom pops the question — out of the blue, because they have barely touched. Patrick toasts them at their wedding. He even shows up during the honeymoon to cook a fancy dinner. All goes well until Tom blows up at Patrick at the dining table.

In any case, all this is Marion's memory of their courtship. There

is another version. It's one that older Marion reads about in Patrick's diaries. We then return to the same scenes from Patrick's perspective.

While the sex scenes between Tom and Patrick generate all the heat, his marriage to Marion is not loveless. They do have a genuine union, and Tom tries to have both Marion and Patrick — only partly because his gay relationship must remain secret.

Tragedy strikes, and it is painful to watch what happens to the relationship.

It is, finally, Everett's face that haunts the final tableau, a compelling few seconds that brings some closure and gives us, perhaps, a slight ray of hope.

As for Styles and his movie-star prospects? Give him some time. The jury's still out.

Holiday Eggnog The Myths Debunked

Whether or not you're a fan of eggnog, odds are someone in your family is bringing it to your New Year's gathering. If not made properly, the recipe could include Salmonel-

This is especially dangerous if you are serving people at high risk for foodborne infections: young children and pregnant women, older adults, and people with weakened immune systems.

Each year this creamy drink causes many cases of Salmonella. The ingredient responsible? It is usually raw or undercooked eggs that cause the problems.

Eggs are a standard ingredient in most homemade eggnog recipes, giving the beverage its characteristic frothy texture.

- SINCE 1917 -

Eggnog recipes vary greatly, and the use as coffee creamer or part of a cocktail doesn't mean that bacteria aren't finding their way into your drinks.

Here are some answers to common eggnog questions and how to keep your eggnog free of harmful pathogens.

Myth #1 — Alcohol kills bacteria in eggnog

Some people think that adding rum, whiskey or other alcohol to the recipe will make the eggnog safe. But, the alcohol in the drink does not kill bacteria.

Myth #2 — Adding eggnog to hot coffee kills bacteria

At its very hottest, coffee is served at 160 to 185 degrees F. But the adding of cold

cream quickly drops the temperature of your beverage. To be sure that any Salmonella is killed in eggnog, the mixture must be cooked to an internal temperature of 160 degrees F.

Myth #3 — All store-bought eggnog have raw eggs

The eggs in store-bought eggnogs have been pasteurized. This is a process of cooking the eggs by heating the drink to high temperatures for a short time in order to kill any bacteria or microorganisms that may be present.

How to make safe eggnog:

The FDA advises consumers to start with a cooked egg base for eggnog.

To make a cooked egg base:

Combine eggs and half the milk as indicated in the recipe. Other ingredients, such as sugar may be added at this step.

Cook the mixture gently to an internal temperature of 160 degrees F, stirring constantly. The cooking will destroy Salmonella, if present.

After cooking, chill the mixture before adding the rest of the milk and other

ingredients such as cinnamon.

Other options for safe eggnog

You can also use egg substitute products or pasteurized eggs in your eggnog, or you can find a recipe without eggs.

With the egg substitute products, you might have to experiment a bit with the recipe to figure out the right amount to add for the best flavor.

Pasteurized eggs can also be used in place of raw eggs. Commercial pasteurization of eggs is a heat process at low temperatures that destroys Salmonella that might be present, without having a noticeable effect on flavor or nutritional content. These are available at some supermarkets for a slightly higher cost than unpasteurized eggs. Even if you're using pasteurized eggs for your eggnog, both the FDA and the USDA recommend starting with a cooked egg base for optimal safety.

So, by following these safe handling and proper cooking practices, you can enjoy delicious, creamy homemade eggnog without worrying about making anyone sick for the beginning of the New Year.

Give Snow Shoeing A Try

uring this time of year I often find myself looking for outdoor recreational opportunities. Along with the holidays and all the extra eating that goes along with them comes time off and the need to go out and get some exercise.

One activity that is a relatively new discovery for me is snowshoeing, and it seems I enjoy it more and get more out of it



each time I strap the things on my feet and head out into the woods or across a field after a fresh snowfall. I have had the experience be one of quiet and solitude with barely a sound aside from the snow falling from the

I have also had the privilege of watching a marsh hawk dive repeatedly into a clump of cattails trying to come up with a mouse or a bobcat sitting at the edge of a field with his back to me, intent on spotting his next meal and seemingly unaware that I was watching from the woods. I have found owl pellets under the trees and spent 10 Minutes scanning above me, certain I would see my first Great Horned Owl resting in the branches above, and I have seen numerous tracks in the snow. many easily identified - some not so easily. You just never know what might happen or what you'll see until you get out there.

If you'd like to try snowshoeing it really doesn't require much in the way of specialized equipment besides the shoes themselves. The pair that I use are actually borrowed and were purchased by my father-in-law from E.M.S. There are many similar pairs available online or at any of the



outdoor outfitters for between \$100-\$200 new and I'm sure it wouldn't be hard to find a used pair if you were so inclined. Most if not all have toe clips and adjustable straps. You just wear your Pac boots. Gore-tex pants or Gators are advisable as you tend to kick quite a bit of snow up on to the back of your legs as you walk. A pair of ski poles are also useful for balance and help negotiating obstacles like fallen trees, small streams and old stonewalls.

As with any outdoor activity at this time of year you'll want to dress in layers so you can make adjustments as you warm up and cool down. Carry a pack to stow those articles of clothing you peel off, some H2O and maybe a pair of Binos and you should be good to go.

How to Keep Your Dog Healthy Flea Free

leas are one of the worst side effects of owning a dog. The dog invariably has to go outside. In the grass, the sand, the weeds, and in fact just you will notice these things immediately. about any outdoor surface, lies a little vampire just waiting for its next victim.

A flea can jump anywhere within a 6 foot radius. Their legs can propel their bodies amazing distances when comparing body size to measurable distance. And if they catch a scent of you, they can hunt you down quickly.

The Common Flea

To see a live flea usually strikes panic in dog owners. This is because these little creatures are rarely seen unless you are specifically looking for them. They are about the size of the diameter of a pin. They are varying colors of brown. And you can squeeze one with all the strength you have and not harm it the flea at all.

The flea is the number one infestation your dog is likely to come into contact with. They live by drinking blood. They can attach themselves to skin and hair follicles. Fleas start off as eggs, hatch, and move through the stages of their lives quickly. The flea can lay hundreds of eggs each day. Your dog might even roll over on its back and wriggle all over on your carpet.

Skin Irritation - Fleas have saliva that skin does not tolerate. It is the saliva that inflames skin.

If the fleas concentrate in an area, or your dog is allergic to the saliva, the area is going to lose hair and become inflamed. This area could loose all the hair. The skin could look really dry like a sun burn,

flaking off from your dog. It can even become infected from the combination of the attacks, your dog's skin reaction, and your dog's physical reaction of the fleas (biting, nipping, and scratching).

Get Rid Of These Fleas

Treating the dog is the first priority. Unfortunately it does not stop there. Once a flea rides your dog into the house, they have a tendency to lay eggs everywhere. And more than likely it has been a few days and you have several generations of fleas throughout your house.

You will have to get something for the dog that kills everything from eggs to adults. Then you will probably have to buy a separate attack for the house. There are foggers,

use. Again, the important thing is that it kills all stages from eggs to adults.

PETPOURRIE

It usually goes something like this: 1) treat the dog (bath using flea shampoo, combing, and then treatment) 2) house attack. 3) wash all bedding, clothing, drapes, towels, etc. 4) vacuum floor to suck up dead and eggs. 5) treat carpet again in the morning 6) vacuum at night. 7) repeat 5 and 6 until you are confident new eggs, hatchlings, newbies, and soon to be adults survived.

Now you have to complete the tasks by spraying or fogging your yard. This is where the dog picked up the fleas more than likely. Hopefully, the two fold attack on both the inside and the outside of your house will eliminate the flea issue. Is There An Easier Way?

Remember the old adage, "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure"? It holds true for fleas too.

Purchase a topical flea solution from your vet. The most common are Advantage and Revolution. Some vets also offer flea dip baths powders, and other types that you can that kills fleas, ticks, and other pests.

Fritz Turner, 23, returned to his hometown of Newport, Washington, to find the city's Christmas tree "embarrassing." The scant trimming comprised a series of vertical rope lights dangling from the top of the tree down the sides, The News Tribune reported. "This is not gonna do," he said. So he set up a GoFundMe page on Dec. 2, hoping to raise \$5,000 for better lights and more decorations. "We can do better. Even Charlie Brown's Christmas tree looked better than this sad spruce," he wrote. The page raised more than \$2,700 for the lights, and the local utility company hung them on the tree. And middle- and high school students donated handmade ornaments for it. For the first time in many years, the chamber of commerce organized a tree-lighting ceremony on Dec. 11. Turner said he's been "inspired" by the support. "Together, we're really powerful."

Chutzpah

On Dec. 6, Laura Oglesby, 48, pleaded guilty to one count of intentionally providing false information to the Social Security Administration, The New York Times reported. Her story is much more complicated than that one charge. In 2016, Oglesby used her estranged daughter's identity to create another life for herself as Lauren Hays, a 22-year-old college student in Mountain View, Missouri. She obtained a Social Security card and driver's license, then racked up more than \$25,000 in debt with student loans and other expenses. She also worked at Southwest Baptist University and rented a room from Wendy and Avery Parker. "Everybody believed it," said Mountain View Police Chief Jamie Perkins. "She even had boyfriends that believed that she was that age: 22 years old." Oglesby may face up to five years in prison and will have to pay restitution to her daughter and SBU.

Thankfully, a sign on Interstate 95 in Delaware directing drivers to a Wilmington exit was only temporary, but that didn't stop commuters from noticing it. The Associated Press reported that the sign was missing an "A" in the avenue's name ("Delware"); transportation officials said it was made in a hurry in case the permanent sign didn't arrive in time for the opening of the exit, which had been under construction. Those large inflatable Christmas decorations may fill the hearts of children with holiday cheer, but one young ursid saw a sparring partner and went on the attack in Monrovia, California, on Dec. 8. Donna Hargett captured video of a bear cub wrestling with her neighbor's inflatable reindeer as the mama bear looked on, United Press International reported. "I looked up and there it was, jumping on the reindeer," Hargett said. "We see these two around all the time. They're trouble," she said. In fact, Hargett said they once broke into her home and left paw prints on the bed. No word on Rudolph's condition.

Lauras Matiusovas, 30, was suddenly (and mistakenly) released from the Pentonville Prison in North London on Nov. 26 after serving only 48 hours of a four-year sentence. After he called the probation officer, who told him that everything was in order, Matiusovas did what any grateful con would do: He embarked on a 10-day boozing binge with his friends. "It's mad," one buddy said, according to the Daily Star. "He could have jumped on a flight and left the U.K. Instead, he chilled with us and had a great time." But it all came to an end on Dec. 6, when he was hauled back to his cell. The Ministry of Justice commented: "Releases in error are incredibly rare, but we take them extremely seriously."

Sure, the Greatest Generation may be coasting down the road at 32 mph in their Le Sabres, much to other drivers' frustration, but Buicks weren't always old-man cars. In fact, car collector Anthony Saia sold a 1987 Buick GNX on eBay on Dec. 11 for \$249,999, Fox News reported. The GNX, part of a limited edition of 547 built for only one year, was produced by Buick along with McLaren Engines and ASC Inc. It was the second-fastest 0-to-60 mph car of its day (behind the Porsche 911 Turbo), and others have sold for similar amounts. Saia's car had 426 miles on it. [
