





Best Pathways To Reach The **Hollywood Sign And What To Bring with You**

The Hollywood Sign is one of the most iconic landmarks in Los Angeles, a symbol of the city. Hiking to the Hollywood Sign is a must-do, offering stunning views of the city and the opportunity to get close to an international symbol. While there is no direct access to the sign itself, several trails provide fantastic viewpoints and the chance to experience Griffith Park.

The Mount Hollywood Trail

Distance: 5 miles round trip Difficulty: Easy to moderate

The Mount Hollywood Trail is one of the most popular options for those seeking an



easy-to-moderate hike with views. Starting at the Griffith Observatory, this trail offers a gentle climb and rewards hikers with panoramic views of Los Angeles and the Hollywood Sign. Along the way, you'll be

treated to lush greenery, the observatory itself, and sweeping vistas of the city and the sign in the background. This trail is ideal for beginners or families, as it is relatively short and not too strenuous. It's also an excellent option if vou're looking to visit the Griffith Observatory.

Directions: Park near the Griffith Observatory, and the trailhead is just to the right of the observatory's main entrance. Follow the signs for the Mount Hollywood Trail.

The Brush Canyon Trail

Distance: 6.4 miles round trip

Difficulty: Moderate



The Brush Canyon Trail is a favorite for those looking to get a bit closer to the Hollywood Sign. Starting from the Brush Canyon Trailhead, this hike takes you on a scenic route through the canyon, surrounded by chaparral, cacti, and stunning views. As you ascend, the sign gets larger, and you'll eventually arrive at a viewpoint just behind the sign.

This trail is moderately challenging, with a steady incline, but the reward is worth it. You'll be treated to breathtaking views of the Los Angeles skyline, the Hollywood Reservoir, and, of course, the Hollywood Sign itself.

Directions: Park at the end of Canyon Drive and follow the Brush Canvon Trail. The trail is well-marked and easy to navigate. The Cahuenga Peak and Wisdom Tree Trail

Distance: 5.7 miles round trip Difficulty: Difficult

For those looking for a challenging hike, the Cahuenga Peak and Wisdom Tree Trail offers a rigorous trek with some of the best views. Starting near the Hollywood Reservoir, this trail leads you up to Cahuenga Peak, the highest point in Griffith Park, which offers unobstructed views of the city. Along the way, you'll pass the famous Wisdom Tree, a solitary tree that has become a symbol of resilience after surviving a devastating wildfire.

After reaching Cahuenga Peak, the trail continues to the ridge behind the Hollywood Sign, offering a unique perspective from the back. This trail is steeper and rockier than others, so it's best suited for experienced hikers.

Directions: Park near the trailhead on Wonder View Drive and follow the signs for the Wisdom Tree and Cahuenga Peak.

The Hollvridge Trail

Distance: 3.5 miles round trip Difficulty: Easy to moderate

The Hollyridge Trail is another popular option. This trail offers a relatively easy hike, making it a great option for families or those who prefer a shorter hike. The trailhead starts at the end of Beachwood Drive, which leads you through the Hollywood Hills before connecting with other trails in Griffith Park.

This trail offers a more leisurely route, with plenty of shade, making it ideal for those who want a relaxing hike without too much elevation gain.

Directions: The trailhead is located at the end of Beachwood Drive, but be aware that parking can be limited in this residential area. What to Bring with You

Regardless of which trail you choose, preparing for your hike to the Hollywood Sign is essential. Here's what to bring with you:

Water: Hydration is key, especially during the hot and dry summer months. Bring at least a liter of water per person.

Sun Protection: The California sun can be intense. Make sure to bring sunscreen, a hat, and sunglasses to protect yourself from UV rays.

Comfortable Footwear: Proper footwear is crucial, especially on rocky or uneven terrain. Wear comfortable, supportive hiking boots or shoes with good grip to prevent slipping or discomfort.





WOMAN OF THE HOUR By Contributing Writer

n Anna Kendrick's "Woman of the Hour," a chilling, based-on-a-true-story drama about when a 1970s serial killer appeared on an episode of "The Dating Game," one of the most telling images isn't a grisly murder scene. It's Pete Holmes' face.

Kendrick, making her directorial debut, stars as an aspiring actor named Cheryl Bradshaw who winds up a contestant on that particular "Dating Game" episode. She's venting about her



audition frustrations with a neighbor (Holmes). After he makes an awkward pass, she recoils and he sits heavily, staring in disappointment.

The tension of those encounters, and how women are forced to handle, and suffer, bruised egos of men, fuels "Woman of the Hour," a sometimes awkwardly plotted but consistently insightful thriller about the anxiety of the female experience and the grim game of weighing the threat of potential danger in men.

Kendrick, working from a script by Ian McDonald, opens "Woman of the Hour" with a scene in the remote foothills of Wyoming. There, Rodney Alcala (Daniel Zovatto) is playfully photographing a young woman (Kelley Jakle) but soon has his hands around her throat.

Though the film then shifts primarily to Cheryl taping "The Dating Game," "Woman of the Hour" is interspersed with similarly gruesome encounters between Alcala and women. They follow a similar pattern. He's charming and even sensitive, but turns violent at the first sign of rejection.

"Woman of the Hour" isn't your standard true crime dramatization. The perspective of Alcala, who was convicted in 1980 of killing seven women and girls and died on death row in 2021, isn't the one that matters here. It's the women he targeted.


Kendrick's movie might have been a better, more suspenseful film if it could have stayed in one timeline and teased all of the drama out of the "Dating Game" taping. But in unmasking Alcala from the start, "Woman of the Hour" becomes more about the horror of a killer who thrived out in the open, even on national television. We watch in dread at just how easily he blends in next to bachelor one and bachelor two—and even seems like the most appealing of the bunch.

When Cheryl is thrust into the showbiz swirl of "The Dating Game," all of the sexist remarks and misogynistic underpinnings of the show appear only more sinister given Alcala's presence. The host, a fictionalized Jim Lange named Ed Burke, is played with expert, flippant sleaze by Tony Hale. Kendrick keeps the camera on Cheryl's face in the makeup chair while Ed, just before showtime, tells her not to act too smart. "I just need you to laugh and smile over and over," he says.

Plenty more sexism is baked into the show. (One of Cheryl's cue cards reads: "My favorite hobby is kissing.") The juxtaposition of a serial killer of women with Hollywood misogyny adds a potent layer. (Kendrick has said an audition exchange early in the film about doing on-camera nudity is taken verbatim from her own experience as a young actor.) That's particularly true when an audience member, Laura (Nicolette Robinson), recognizes Alcala as the man who killed her friend. Her attempts to warn producers are met predictably.

Though Zovatto's performance is compellingly unsettling without being over-the-top, the dark, disturbed nature of Alcala is too much for "Woman of the Hour" to reckon with. This was a killer whose path of heinous violence included the rape and near-murder of an 8-year-old girl and the killing of a 12-year-old biking home from ballet class. The years of police and judicial failure that allowed Alcala to avoid imprisonment for so long are only hinted at here.

"Woman of the Hour" will surely send many looking up this stranger-than-fiction story. But Kendrick's achievement is in capturing, from a woman's point of view, just how hard it can be to pick a serial killer out of an all-male line-up.



n an early scene in "Smile 2," the fictional pop superstar Skye Riley is in her drug dealer's apartment. "Do you believe in weird stuff?" he asks her, between doing lines of coke.



You certainly will after this horror romp—writer-director Parker Finn's second movie that suddenly opens up the franchise with the promises of multiple directions in the future. Not for that drug dealer, though: He soon smiles at her demonically as he repeatedly slams a 35-pound gym weight into his head, making it hamburger.



"Smile 2" lands as unsettling grins are plastered on pumpkins and politicians alike as we approach Halloween and Election Day, and the psychotic, overly made-up leads of "Joker: Folie à Deux" have been putting up a brave face at their terrible box-office numbers.

So it's the perfect time for a sequel to 2020's "Smile," which bridged the gap

between elevated art horror and straight-out, unapologetic slasher. Finn this time takes on fame, a better tonal fit than the generational trauma of the first. It's a meditation on breakdowns in the public eye, with a side dish of body horror.

Finn has become a much more assured filmmaker and uses humor so well here, from nasty gangsters enjoying pumpkin Frappuccinos to our heroine Googling "Does vomit have DNA?" He's still fond of jump-scares and blood spurting and gross-out tricks, like a body dragged by a truck until it's just a smear with entrails. One delightful moment has Skye chased by demonic backup dancers, a Bob Fosse-meets-"Thriller" sequence.



Finn also has a ball putting his heroines into cringe-worthy situations. In the first movie, a murdered cat got bundled into a kid's birthday present. In this one, it's a impromptu speech in front of music industry types that goes horrifically off the rails. He's got a deeper target: How do we quiet those voices in our heads that say we're no good?

Finn's script sometime lags as he searches for an ending for "Smile 2," seemingly in two minds, before basically delivering both, kicking up dream sequences and alternate timelines like a squid pumping out ink to cover its tracks. Over two hours ends up being too long.

But he has found a great satirical target, given life to a third film easily and show-cased another rising star to watch. That's a reason to, well, smile about.



NOT YOUR MOTHER'S TIMESHARE

imeshares. The concept is arguably one of the most – if not the most – confusing travel experiences on the planet. Created in the early 1970s and '80s it's actually – surprise, surprise – the world's first "shared economy" product. Where people bought a "share" of time at a condo in a destination of their choice.

Times have changed. And so have timeshares. As I learned covering the Spring 2024 ARDA (American Resort Development Association) Conference, "Timeshare Together," in Las Vegas.

The industry has blossomed into a menu of options and freedom of choices and times including experiences, cruises,

special events and hotel and resort stays from overwater the U.S., according to ARDA. Many owners have more than one. Often sharing multiple ownerships with friends.

Value - Not Real Estate

No longer a real estate transaction where you'd "buy an annual week's stay at a specific condo." Today's owners choose when, where and what experiences they want. This can be "flexible two- to 10-day vacations anywhere! Multiple times," explained Tom Shelburne, chief marketing officer for Travel + Leisure Co., a timeshare company. "Today's timeshare has more in common with a country club," he enthused. "Comradery, friendship. It's ownership in a system of exclusive membership benefits," like Disney Vacation Club packages, and





bungalows in Tahiti to Manhattan high rises.

"The timeshare was ahead of its time," ARDA President & CEO Jason Gamel told me during our one-on-one interview. "Now others are catching up – Uber, Lyft, Air B&B." With the shared economy mainstream, timeshares "are trending," explained Jon Last, president and founder of the Sport and Leisure Research Group. Sixty-six percent of first-time timeshare buyers are Millennials and Gen Xers, with an average owner age of 39, he cited. In 2023, timeshare occupancy as up 68 percent, he said. With 700,000 member properties, and 900,000 owners, 86 percent of whom live in

perks like waterparks, tours, flights, cruises, rock concerts, loyalty programs, arranged activities, and restaurant meals."

Points Based

To be clear, "timeshare" is still real estate, Gamel told me. But the emphasis is on experiences and destinations, using a point system. "It's your points that give you access (exchange power) to all these different experiences." The number of points you have depends on the size, destination and type of timeshare you purchase. You exchange the points your time share is worth for whatever experience you want, explained Chris McGill, director of development for Interval International, one of the top two vacation ownership exchange companies.

Who Should Own a Timeshare?

"Timeshares are not for everyone."

Gamel is the first to admit this. "Timeshares are for folks who want to travel regularly. It forces you to take a vacation because it's reoccurring and you need to take advantage of it. And families! "Timeshares are excellent for families and multi-generational families, who need to plan blended

vacations months in advance. Also, vacationers who appreciate a kitchen, washer/dryer, and multi-bedrooms."

What Owners Say

"Top quality accommodations, individual bedrooms, and a washer/dryer," are the most often heard comments from families and couples, according to Gamel. Also, "travelers enjoy having a room that's more than 200 square feet." Timeshare units average 1,500 square feet, according to ARDA.

All the biggies: Marriott Vacations Worldwide, Accor, Hilton Grand Vacation Club, Margaritaville Vacation Club, Hyatt Residence Club, Club Wyndham, Holiday Inn Club Vacations, Westgate Resorts, Fairfield Inn. The Swan and Dolphin hotels in Orlando. You can timeshare vacation in17 countries and – newly added – in popular urban destinations including ski resorts, college towns and Las Vegas, perhaps in the


lavish timeshare penthouse suites atop the new Elara, a Hilton Grand Vacations Club.

What's the Cost?

A one-week, two-bedroom unit, averages \$24,000, said Gamel. "The majority of new timeshare owners take out a mortgage.
Usually seven years." Price also depends on the buyer's "right to use" plan, which can be 10, 20, 30 or 40 years. You're no longer locked in forever! Maintenance fees and property taxes average \$1,200 a year, according to Gamel. Owners see it "as an investment. And protection against inflation," he said. As travel costs go up, you save because you're traveling on just your maintenance and taxes, which are under the national inflation rate."

Yes! You Can Get Out

"The timeshare industry has an exit product, where they will sell your timeshare," said Gamel. Since 2018, Responsible Exit options are available.



At the annual World Conker Championship in Southwick, England, on Oct. 13, veteran player Dave Jakins, 82, won the men's tournament, the Associated Press reported. (Conkers is a traditional game played using the seeds of horse chestnut trees threaded on string; players try to strike and break each other's conkers.) But controversy followed when Jakins was found to have a steel conker in his pocket. His opponent, Alastair Johnson-Ferguson, said his own conker "disintegrated in one hit" after Jakins struck it. "He was very closely watched by four judges," said St. John Burkett, chair of the event's organizing committee. "It looks like it was absolutely impossible for him to cheat." Jakins has denied cheating.

An unnamed woman in Kitsap County, Washington, admitted to authorities that she'd been feeding about "a dozen" raccoons in her yard over the past 35 years, The New York Times reported. Several weeks ago, more raccoons started showing up, and on Oct. 3, the homeowner had to call 911 when about 100 animals arrived and became more aggressive. "Anytime she comes out of her house," said sheriff's department spokesperson Kevin McCarty, "they swarm her until she throws them food. ... The new ones showing up scare her." The woman fled her home, and local trappers were going to charge \$500 per animal to remove the raccoons. So the state department of fish and wildlife stepped in, suggesting that she simply stop feeding them. "The raccoons appear to have started dispersing now that they are no longer being fed," the department said.

- -- When cops in Portland, Oregon, pulled over a 1994 Ford Taurus that had been stolen on Oct. 9, they met Reginald Reynolds, 35, and Mia Baggenstos, 37, along with their toys: a loaded .357 Magnum, a bag of methamphetamine, \$1,360 in cash, three white pills that Baggenstos said were OxyContin, and a meth pipe. The Smoking Gun reported that a vehicle search yielded more meth, two scales, and a "brown bag that said on it, 'Definitely not a bag full of drugs." Inside, they found more meth -- a total of about a half-pound. Both were charged with multiple felonies.
- -- In Stadtallendorf, Germany, on Oct. 16, a state-of-the-art fire station that had been open less than a year ... burned to the

ground, The Guardian reported. The fire started in a vehicle and quickly spread, destroying 10 fire engines and causing between 20 and 24 million euros' worth of damage. "It is a nightmare for a firefighter," said district fire inspector Lars Schafer. He went on to say that the station was not required to have fire alarms because it was classified as a building holding equipment. Schafer said the building would be reconstructed quickly, for safety and for local morale.

-- In early October, The New York Times reported, passengers aboard a Qantas flight from Sydney, Australia, to Tokyo were treated (or not) to an R-rated film with "sexual material and brief graphic nudity" on their seat screens -- and it couldn't be turned off. Because of technological problems, passengers weren't able to choose their entertainment, so the crew queued up "Daddio," starring Dakota Johnson and Sean Penn, and let it run for about an hour before switching to something more family-friendly. "It was super uncomfortable for everyone," one Reddit user wrote. "We apologize to customers for this experience," a Qantas spokesperson said.


-- The BBC apologized on Oct. 10 after releasing a weather forecast predicting winds in London of 20,000 kilometers (13,000 miles) per hour, Yahoo! News reported. Matt Taylor, a meteorologist for the network, soothed concerns: "Hurricane Milton hasn't made it to us here in the U.K.!" He added that a data glitch had caused the extreme forecast, also warning of overnight temperatures of 759 degrees Fahrenheit in Nottingham. "Folk are working to solve the issue," Taylor assured Brits.

In Port St. Lucie, Florida, on Oct. 14. police responded to a report of an explosion, WPBF-TV reported. As they arrived at the scene, Joseph Moreton, 39, began yelling at them from his backyard, then came into the front yard holding a flamethrower. Police asked Moreton to drop the weapon, but he wouldn't -- luckily, one officer was close enough to grab it out of his hands. Moreton then moved inside his house and got a flashlight, which he tried to blind officers with. Law enforcement tased him, and he was taken into custody. Moreton was charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and resisting an officer.




