LILYPADA

A NEW ORIGINAL MUSICAL FOR ALL AGES COMBINING MUSICAL THEATER AND BALLET

Inland Pacific Ballet presents the world premiere of LilYpada, a new original musical for all ages, combining musical theater and ballet, a journey in song that has a connection to Rancho Cucamonga, with two magical performances on Saturday, March 11 and Sunday, March 12 at 2:00 p.m. at the Lewis Family Playhouse in Rancho Cucamonga.

Change is in the air when young Liya learns her mother is planning to move them from New York City back to her hometown of Rancho Cucamonga. Her Grammy and Grandpa are excited, but Liya doesn't want to leave all her friends at the Performing Arts School she has been attending. She looks for guidance from her father, but he

only gives her a mysterious message about a secret garden.

Falling asleep and dreaming, Liya is transported and lost in an imaginary land inhabited by the Lilypas, beautiful giant dancing butterflies. Ruled by Queen Lilypas, Liya is offered help to get home and introduced to a cadre of comical characters who will keep her safe from the OooAaas and Bat Faith. With help from Libelle, Jack the Turtle, Thorn the Twisted Beetle, Sir Snobby Snail, the Lilypas and others, Liya must go on a quest to find her way home. Along the way, she learns to fly with joy – overcoming her fears and learning to believe in herself while respecting the differences in others.







According to Zaylin Cano, LilYpada Director, "The story of LilYpada originated in 2015 with only a few scenes and characters during our IPB Academy Summer Intensive, and we continued to develop the story over the past 7 years. It is a completely original story with all original music. The 66 talented members of the cast are so excited to be involved. The music is outstanding with memorable melodies and rich harmonies. The story has depth and is one that adults and kids will relate to, and we think the audience will have a great time too."

LilYpada features a cast of 66 talented performers including Musical Theater Guest Artists Debbie Prutsman (well-known diva in the musical theater world) and Jonathan Sharp (appeared in the original Broadway casts of The Red Shoes, Carousel, The Rocky Horror Show Live, The Dance of the Vampires, and Fiddler on the Roof), Inland Pacific Ballet Company, IPB Academy Apprentices/Trainees, IPB Academy Musical Theater Troupe and Students, 10-member Citrus Singers Ensemble, and Live music by a 10-piece musical ensemble. Original music, book, and lyrics by Hugues-Jocelyn Cano; directed by IPB Executive Director Zavlin Cano; Marius Beltran is the Music Director; Choreographed by Zaylin Cano, Joshua Collins, Brandon J, and Michael Milligan; Scenic Design by Daniel C. Nyiri and Robert Wollenzier; and Lighting Design by Stephen Yarbrough.

"The show is similar to the Wizard of

Oz in that it has human characters that are also represented in the imaginary land of LilYpada such as a Jack the Turtle, Sir Snobby Snail and Libelle, a dragonfly. Each of these creature characters represents a virtue that is shared with the main character Liya, and each is presented through a signature style of music. The idea to use different musical genres such as blues, jazz, samba, hip-hop, bluegrass and other styles of music came naturally as we developed the characters," exclaims Hugues-Jocelyn Cano.






Catalina Jazz Club Presents The CD Debut Album Release of, "GINA ZOLLMAN: Anywhere With You"

Gina Zollman (Singer/Songwriter) lives in Palm Springs, CA. She was born in Long Beach, CA and in her youth moved to Garden Grove, CA. Zollman started singing at six years of age, with a performance at a jam-packed PTA meeting. She sang in choirs from 4th grade through and beyond college. She performed in numerous stage shows, appearing as Ballin in "The Hobbit" and Aunt Eller in "Oklahoma!," with braces on her teeth, while attending the private girl's high school, Marywood, in Villa Park, CA.

Zollman graduated from the University of California, San Diego (UCSD), Revelle College with a B.A. Degree in Linguistics and a minor in Music. Parapod Festival a two-day celebration of the paranormal

o you believe in the paranormal? The paranormal is defined as events or phenomena beyond the scope of common scientific understanding. It encompasses everything from UFOs and aliens to ghosts and hauntings, Bigfoot and other cryptids, psychics, spiritual studies, and ancient mysteries.

Parapod Festival is excited to bring a two-day celebration of the paranormal to Santa Clarita on March 31 and April 1, with events at Santa Clarita's Mentryville Park and the Hyatt Regency Valencia for those interested in these strange and unusual subjects.

There is a vast number of YouTube channels, TikTok and Instagram accounts, and websites that are devoted to the paranormal genre. There is everything from documentaries to web series to podcasts. No one knows this more than Creator and Event Director Tony Sweet, whose paranormal video podcast Truth Be Told Paranormal has been in the top 5 percent of podcasts worldwide for the past decade.

Sweet's interest in the paranormal began at a young age. "The house I grew up in was an older home built in the early 1900s," he says. "When I was around six or seven, I used to see an apparition of an old man in a chair who never moved. My family would also hear things, see things, and the hairs would stick up on your arm!"

His family also experienced an unusual craft in the sky – a UFO! "We saw a UFO hovering above a lake," he says. "It didn't make any noise or move, and then a small single-engine plane was flying by it. It turned around, flew up in the air, and disappeared."

The Parapod Festival will feature a daytime ghost investigation of a real-life oil-boom ghost town, an evening of stargazing with television host Ben Hansen of Fact or Faked Paranormal Files, and a nighttime tour of the allegedly haunted Mentry mansion with the White Witch of Hollywood Patti Negri on Friday.

Saturday's events will include guest lectures and workshops with a roster of world-renowned speakers, meditation in the garden, a sound bath, Native American dance, and more. Saturday also sees the exclusive ParaPod Awards, a ceremony to honor paranormal content creators such as podcasters, documentary filmmakers, and established media personalities. A vendor marketplace will also sell wares such as crystals, artwork, and psychic readings. Food trucks will also be available.

Other speakers of note include Professor Robert Schoch, a world-renowned geologist who deals with ancient civilizations, ancient Egypt, and other sites worldwide; Billy Carson, who will receive the festival's Pioneer Award, is a noted author, CEO of 4biddenknowledge, and host of Gaia's popular streaming show Deep Space, he will talk about philosophies of climate change and ancient civilizations; and Ernie Lapoint, the great-grandson of Sitting Bull, he will speak about his great-grandfather and Native American spirits and spirit guides.

There will also be Ron James of MUFON and All Things UFO, which airs on the UFO network. He will be talking about the latest sightings of UFOs. And then Ronnie LeBlanc, an investigator for Expedition Bigfoot, will be talking about recent sightings of Bigfoot. Peabody Award-winning investigative journalist Linda Moulton Howe of Ancient Aliens and Truth Hunter will receive the festival's Media Legend Award. The master of ceremonies for the ParaPod Festival is Jimmy Church, host of the famous Fade to

Black podcast.

The award ceremony will be a considerable part of the festival, recognizing podcasters and personalities in the nonfiction paranormal genre. "I just never understood why podcasters didn't get the accolades or praise they deserve. So my goal is to spotlight content creators," says

Sweet. "It is a dream come true to give awards to podcasters, filmmakers, and investigators who continue to move the paranormal genre closer to the mainstream." Awards include Best Podcast, Best Podcast Host, Best Ghost Podcast, Best True Crime Podcast, Best Spiritual Podcast, and more.

"With the Parapod festival, we're bringing all things paranormal together, where a lot of conferences are particular – one could be about ghosts, one could be about true crime, one could be about UFOs," says Sweet. "It's rare to bring everything under one roof. That's what makes us unique."

Tickets to ParaPod Festival start at \$25 for individual events at Mentryville; Saturday's General Admission is \$35, and the VIP Weekend Pass includes all events on both days for \$175. eyton Reed's "Ant-Man" films have served as a palate cleanser to the world-ending stakes of the Marvel Cinematic Universe. Paul Rudd's Scott Lang is an ordinary dude, who still can't believe that he's part of the Avengers. He gets to be the wide-eyed middle-aged fanboy of the group. In his own films, he's just living life in San Francisco as an affable single dad and ex-con and who has occasional enemies to defeat.

In "Ant-Man and The Wasp: Quantumania,"he's coasting on his own post-Blip celebrity with a best-selling memoir, lots of fans and a generally sunny disposition — when he's not breaking his teenage daughter Cassie (Kathryn Newton) out of jail.

There is a fun sitcom-y touch to these early scenes in which he and his makeshift family, Hope Van Dyne (Evangeline Lilly), Janet Van Dyne (Michelle Pfeiffer) and Hank Pym (Michael Douglas) sit around the table for pizza. They use their technology to blow up the pie.

"Tjust saved us \$8," Pym declares. But Ant-Man is part of the larger chess board, so naturally he's



doomed to be sucked into the multiverse, setting up pieces for more Avengers films with a new villain, Kang (Jonathan Majors). The results are mixed. Reed has returned with a new writer, Jeff Loveness, who has also been tapped to write "Avengers: The Kang Dynasty" and it's hard not to empa-

soldiers. But he takes that conceit further and gives the rebels some personality and humor, including William Jackson Harper as the mind-reading Quaz. The villain's a killing machine, M.O.D.O.K., that looks (knowingly) straight out of a "Mystery Science Theater 3000" movie and it is quite enter-

thize with both for the logic gymnastics required

to back Ant-Man and his gang into this conflict.

Loveness, who cut his teeth in comedy

and has an affinity for comic book and B-movie

absurdities, gives Ant-Man his own "Star Wars"-ad-

jacent adventure. There's quite a bit of unrest in the

Quantum Realm, with scrappy rebels battling

against a powerful ruler with an army of faceless

taining. It's both a nod to the fun of the ridiculousness in sci-fi and a reminder that Serious Superhero Films are sometimes just one crazy special effect away from being Silly Superhero Films.

"Quantumania" also gives Pfeiffer a lot more to do as we, and Hank and Hope, learn a little bit more about Janet's 30 years in the Quantum Realm and the various compromises and allegiances she made to stay alive. Pfeiffer is an unambiguous delight and the real center of the movie despite what the title might claim. Ant-Man just finds himself in the middle of the mess, which starts to drag on in a muddle of sci-fi furnishings that individually are probably quite inspired and interesting but together just blend into a dreary mess.

Reed's films are generally so crisp and styled and are best when focused on characters, not worlds and Quantum Realms. "Quantumania" shines when it is keeping things light and quippy.

But Kang, for what we can assume are bigger story needs, needs to be more serious. Majors is certainly chilling and captivating, but Kang seems like a mismatched foe for a standalone Ant-Man film and the result is a "Quantumania" that is trying to be too many things. One thing it is not is a Wasp movie, though. Lilly gets a lot to do but not character development.

"Quantumania" sticks the ending, however. Without giving anything away, we'll just say that Reed and Rudd get to return to their sweet spot, with a bit of a twist.

EMILY

nly two minutes into "Emily," a bold and audacious retelling of Emily Brontë's life starning Emma Mackey, we spy freshly bound volumes of "Wuthering Heights," her only novel.

"By Emily Brontë," the cover says. But Brontë fans will know that Emily, like her sisters Charlotte and Anne, published under a male pseudonym, in her case Ellis Bell. It was both a bid for privacy and a concession to Victorian society.

This change is the first — but not the most important — way in which writer-director Frances O'Connor reimagines the life of the "strange" Brontë, who died at 30, unable to give the world more novels. Most brazenly, O'Connor gives Emily a love affair — fiery, forbidden and ultimately tragic.

Remind you of anything? These are the same "wily, windy moors," where Heathcliff and Catherine lived their doomed love.

O'Connor both tells the story of Brontë's "Wuthering Heights" and places her inside it.

Does it matter that this relationship — with Brontë's real-life, French tutor — is fictional, and that he was possibly involved with sister Anne? Purists will balk, but O'Connor has been frank about creating an augmented life for Emily.

So perhaps it's best to see that name engraved on the book as O'Connor's two-minute warning — if you're looking for only recorded facts, she's saying, stop while you're ahead.

The film poses a question: How did a sheltered young woman, a reverend's daughter, come up with the emotional bandwidth to create "Wuthering Heights?" It's a question asked by older sister Charlotte, who loves but is also jealous of her sister. "There's something you're hiding from me," Charlotte says, demanding to know the inspiration of an "ugly" book. Emily, meanwhile, is deathly ill. She still manages a smile.

We now flash back. Emily, despite her dark and brooding beauty, is a quiet soul, an "odd fish" by her own description. Charlotte thrives at school, where she is offered a teaching post. Emily tries to join her and fails, suffering homesickness.

Emily's father assigns her a French tutor: William Weightman. The young man



(Oliver Jackson-Cohen) has at first a prickly connection to Emily, but things change when they study the language of love. It's great fun to hear the French-born Mackey display rapidly improving French as she grows closer to her tutor. Sex education, indeed.

Mackey is perfectly cast. When her hair is down, when she runs in the rain, or rolls down hills with her beloved Branwell (Fionn Whitehead), we could be in 2023, so contemporary is her look. The young actor's versatility, as she

experiences passion, lust, anger, heartbreak, grief, ambition and more, is something to behold.

In O'Connor's telling, it is clearly this lived experience that forms the basis for the book Emily finally sits down to write. Which raises another question: Is O'Connor arguing that one can only write what one has lived — that a famously fertile imagination is not enough?

O'Connor's own explanation is broader, though. She has called "Emily" her love letter to young women of today, who,

she hopes, will respond to its celebration of one's authentic voice and potential. And that they'll allow themselves to be, essentially, imperfect.

Or, we could say, "strange." Emily asks Branwell if he thinks she is strange at one point, and he responds: "Everyone's strange if you look at them for long enough."

Luckily we get to look long and and hard at this Emily, brought provocatively to life by O'Connor and her star. Strange or not, it's hard to look away.

them runs into problems and may be charged with a fine or taken to the jail as the severity of the circumstance may be.


In my opinion, we should ban human cloning.

Hamantaschen The Tasty Triangle of PURIM

oday we think of hamantaschen, the triangle-shaped stuffed cookie, as the pastry of the Jewish holiday of Purim. But the original hamantaschen had no Jewish connection at all. According to Gil Marks in his landmark book, "Encyclopedia of Jewish Food," the hamantaschen we eat on Purim — and increasingly throughout the year as American bakeries and bakers have embraced them as an evergreen option — are based on a medieval German pastry stuffed with poppy seeds. It was called mohntasche, from the German words for poppy seed (mohn) and pocket (tasche).

By coincidence, mohn sounds like Haman (Hamohn in Hebrew), the supervillain of the Purim story who plotted to annihilate the Jews of Persia. German Jews, wrote Marks, "renamed this Teutonic cookie as hamantasch ..meaning 'Haman's pocket." It was common, in Jewish communities all around the world, to prepare foods for Purim that somehow alluded to Haman, his body, the clothes he wore, or to other characters in the Purim story. In eating those pastries, wrote Marks, a person "symbolically erases Haman's name."



Following the Black Plague in the 14th century, many German Jews fled their homes and migrated eastward, bringing their poppy seed stuffed pastries with them

Shmil Holland, a restaurateur, expert on Eastern European Jewish food, and author of the cookbook, "Schmaltz," says that over time, this "haman's pocket" cookie became associated with Purim in Eastern Europe, and poppy seed became the "ultimate Purim filling." But other fillings gained popularity, too.

The choices were limited, of course, by the time of year and what was available in the markets and the cellars of Eastern Europe. Since Purim falls at the end of winter, the abundant fresh fruits and berries, like cherries, strawberries and raspberries found in the woods and orchards of that region in the warm weather were not an option. Winter fare such as dried fruits,

nuts, poppy seeds, honey or kasha (buckwheat) was. Following a Purim-like story of their

own, the Jews in Bohemia and Czechoslovakia (today's Czech Republic and Slovakia) embraced a special hamantaschen filling called povidl (known as lekvar in the United States) which is a thick spread made from slow cooking the dark purple Damson plums that are harvested in Eastern Europe at the very end of summer. After the fruit and its peel are cooked for 48 hours on a low flame. said Holland, they become a sweet paste. It lasts for months when kept cool in the basement, and it was used in kugels. strudels, cakes and blintzes in central and Eastern Europe. Those same plums are used, too, to make slivovitz, the fiery, high proof plum brandy.

While most Purim baked goods are sweet, symbolic of a sweet future, there were savory options, too. In Poland, said Holland, kasha (buckwheat, in English), a widely available grain, was prepared with fried onions, seasoned with salt and black pepper, stuffed into the triangle-shaped pastry, and then topped with whole poppy seeds.

In Israel today, stores begin filling up with this Eastern European pastry weeks before Purim. You can still get the classic poppy seed filling, but the choices today spread across the culinary spectrum. "Every year," said Holland, "fillings get more creative. You can get hamantaschen filled with pastry cream and chocolate." Of course here in the United States we also have an expansive list of flavors that become part of the always-changing Jewish food landscape. It all started with one humble poppy seed pastry.





What is the optimal position in my garden for a Greenhouse?

For stand-alone, the ridge along the top of the Greenhouse should run from East to West, this will allow the sun to run along its longest side during the day. ing winds for ventilation. Site your Greenhouse in close proximity to an electricity and water supply, and on fertile soil if you want to install growing beds. What water access will I need?


Watering is the most important task in owning a greenhouse, so a water supply is a must. There are automatic watering systems available, but these are not always necessary. We recommend Greenhouse owners make use of sustainable water sources, using water butts to collect rainwater and 'grey' water recycled from baths or sinks. This will save on the tool for growing food but also, an alfresco room amount of water you need to use. > Running electricity directly to your Greenhouse can make your life easier. Fan heaters are efficient at circulating heat. For heating large structures, electricity isn't required - a hot water pipe system is the norm.

Tony Toto and his wife, Frances, of Allentown, Pennsylvania, are celebrating 57 years of marriage, WFMZ-TV reported in a feel-good Valentine's Day story. "We have been blessed that we had all these years," Tony said, noting "that one time when we had a rough time." Yeah, that was the time in 1983 when Frances hired teenaged hitmen five times to kill Tony. "I don't think I was thinking straight," Frances said. "It was like it was a love-hate kind of a thing." Of course, the murder attempts weren't successful, and Frances and the young hitmen were arrested. She spent four years in prison, but their love never wavered. A feature film called "I Love You to Death" was made about their troubles, and they became minor celebrities, traveling to movie premieres and giving interviews. Tony and Frances got counseling and committed to better communication, and decades later, have a long marriage to show for their efforts.

The Aristocrats

On Feb. 11, during an intermission at the Hannover State Opera House in Hannover, Germany, ballet director Marco Goecke shocked even himself when he approached the dance critic from the Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitung newspaper, Wiebke Huester, and smeared animal feces on her face. The Associated Press reported that Goecke was unhappy with a recent review of a production he staged in The Hague. Following the incident, he took off through the crowded theater lobby. But strangely, Goecke seemed to justify his actions in a later interview, saying that after having his work "soiled for years ... Once a certain point has been reached, I disagree." The opera house suspended and banned him from the facility until further notice.

Weird Science

People who suffer from chronic constipation now have a high-tech treatment option: a vibrating pill that stimulates the colon, CNN reported. The Vibrant capsule, prescribed by a doctor, is taken at bedtime and reaches the large intestine about 14 hours later. Vibrations cause the gut to contract, moving food along. Eventually, the capsule is eliminated and makes its way

to a sewage treatment plant, where it's sifted out and sent to a landfill. Dr. Eamonn Quigley of Houston Methodist Hospital helped test the new technology. He said most people couldn't feel it working. "A minority could feel it. None of them felt it was being uncomfortable." But we're uncomfortable just reading this.

Unconventional Weaponry

Christopher Gaddis, 41, was holding a cat in his arms when he was approached by Metro Nashville Police officers on Feb. 8, WSMV-TV reported. Gaddis had two outstanding warrants, and officers were trying to arrest him when he shoved the cat into the face of one of them, leaving several cuts on the officer's hands. Gaddis also kicked the officer. After being treated for his own injuries from the cat, Gaddis was charged with resisting arrest and assaulting an officer.

In what prosecutor Owen Beale called an "organized criminal matter," Joby Pool, 32, pleaded guilty to theft and criminal damage in Kidderminster, England, magistrates court, The Guardian reported. His crime? Pool broke into a warehouse on Feb. 11 and towed away a trailer with about 200,000 Cadbury Creme Eggs, valued at about \$37,000. He didn't get very far; when police stopped him, he "walked toward (them) with his hands up." "This clearly wasn't spur-of-the-moment offending," Beale said. "You don't just happen to learn about a trailer with that kind of value being available." The "Easter bunny," as police dubbed him, will be sentenced in March to about two years in jail.

-- In the Germantown neighborhood of Philadelphia, one gas station is employing a dramatic tactic to try to keep people experiencing homelessness away: blasting opera music over its outdoor speakers. WPVI-TV reported that neighbors aren't fans: "I heard all this music, I couldn't tell where it was coming from. Loud, it was unbelievable that time of night," said Clinton Barnes, who lives close by. "I don't think it's a deterrent," said Karen Clark. "They have to find something else." One neighbor said it was as loud as if someone had "cranked the volume all the way up" on the TV inside their home. Gas station employees refused to comment.

Science Experiments and Stem Activities for Kids


Water is kids' favorite. Period. There are number of activities designed around water.






