

ave you ever wanted to paint and customize your ride to make it truly unique? Then you should check out Chico-based Phunky Auto. Owner Joshua Flores specializes in amazing paint and bodywork to make your car stand out from the crowd.

Joshua grew up working on cars with his dad at their dealership so he always had the motivation of creating vehicles that were amazing and trailblazing. He learned to specialize in repainting and refinishing. As he grew up, friends asked him to work on the cars on the side, and it gradually evolved into a business – Phunky Auto.

"I grew up seeing all my boys with their nice cars. Then my Pop introduced me to cleaning and polishing cars. I learned how to paint and fix them," he says. "I was influenced by being around the car industry."

ydia, a world-renown conductor, is explaining her art - not a mere "human metronome" — but rather a god-like ability to mold and contort time. The way Blanchett says this, makes you believe.

But in "Tár" — a movie that measures and sculpts moments with precision — time may be catching up. Just after the opening credits, Lydia is on a New York stage before a rapt audience being interviewed, and with almost oppressive accuracy, by The New Yorker's Adam Gopnik (as himself). Her listed accomplishments — conductor of the Berlin a colossal tour-de-force performance.

Philharmonic, protégée of Leonard Bernstein, a glass ceiling-shattering figure of the classical music world, an EGOT-winner with a new memoir, "Tár on "Tár," out - are as impressive as her regal, polished stage presence.



Yet an introductory, fleeting moment of a phone camera pointed at an asleep Lydia, with mocking texts filling the screen, presages that the conductor's perch may be in jeopardy. The spaces Lydia occupies are crisply contemporary. It's in these chilly, highbrow environs that Lydia operates with exquisite intellect and cunning - and Blanchett gives

The answers Fields supplies are not always satisfying, but he and Blanchett orchestrate a mesmerizing character study. The first such scene places Lydia, who describes herself off-handedly as "a U-Haul lesbian," as a guest lecturer at Julliard. One describes himself as "a BIPOC pangender person" who is "not into Bach." He shakes as Lydia, calmly tears into him as "a robot." "Don't be so eager to be offended," she says.

Lydia's perspective will rile some and be applauded by others, but in her smooth torrent of words she also makes less controversial, sincere arguments for "sublimating" and "obliterating" one's self before art. Lydia spends much of "Tár" running her business, manipulating the inner-workings of the philharmonic with her personal assistant (Noémie Merlant) and eyeing a young Russian cellist (Sophie Kauer). But when she's rehearsing with the orchestra or in the full thrall of the music, Lydia is masterful. She may always be performing, but that doesn't mean she isn't being herself. "Music is movement," Bernstein is heard saying during the film. Lydia, too, is a force of headlong momentum.

Once the noise that's plagued Lydia finally consumes her, we don't experience her downward spiral as you expect. It's a kind of nuisance. "Tár" sags here and there But I think its misstep comes when the movie's sober spell breaks in a not-believable fit of violence. That I recoiled at these moments is a testament to the deft balance Fields strikes, demurring judgement of Lydia and declining to saddle her with the expected art-vs-artist commentaries. But above all, it's because Blanchett has created such a symphony of a character, one that uses every trick and tone of her vast repertoire, that any wrong note jars. The word I'm looking for is "maestro."

Amsterdam

he stars appear one after the other — a banquet of talent — and yet nothing clicks. Welcome to "Amsterdam," writer and director David O. Russell's answer to the question: Can some of the top actors in the world mange to elevate poor material? The answer is a dull no.

Just look at this lead cast: Christian Bale, Margot Robbie and John David Washington. Russell wastes them with pointless dialogue and tedious scenes.

Then imagine a second tier roles with Alessandro Nivola, Anya Taylor-Joy, Chris Rock, Michael Shannon, Mike Myers, Taylor Swift, Zoe Saldaña, Rami Malek and Robert De Niro. All are left powerless. They are in a charisma-removal machine.

Bale and Washington play World War I veterans and friends - soldiers who crossed the racial divide — and Robbie plays a nurse

who treats them. This bonded trio stumble onto a plot to overthrow the U.S. government while being framed for murder in 1930s New York.

It uses these three characters to explore a real event in which a cabal of American businessmen conspired to overthrow President Franklin D. Roosevelt by duping a retired general into being their figurehead.

"Amsterdam" shifts from 1933 to 1918 as it fills out backstories and love affairs. After returning to the '30s, Bale has become a doctor and Washington's character a lawyer, both helping vets. The nurse is strung out on drugs.

But unable to find a tone the film plods along at its pace, leaving most of the actors befuldled.

It's a film where no one seems to answer a direct question, gruesome autopsies are performed



on camera followed by whimsically sung ditties, and a script that tries for the profound when it says things like people "follow the wrong God home."

"Amsterdam" reaches for something contemporary to say about race relations, concentration of wealth, veterans and fascism but ends up with a plodding, mannerist noise.

Take Bale, who already reached his glass-eye limit onscreen when he starred in "Big Short." Somehow he agreed to another such role, this time with the eyeball popping out numerous times and spilling on the ground. He attacks his role with a weird "Columbo" thing going, tilting angularly and adopting a rich New York accent.

Washington and Robbie have apparently chosen to ignore Bale's lead by acting as if they are in two separate and different movies she plays a manic pixie artist who uses shrapnel to make sculptures and he makes his character stone-faced and passive. Everyone else seems to be badly mimicking old '30s films. (Swift sings at one

point but otherwise she is marooned and wooden.)

It's not just the cast that is taken down: Emmanuel Lubezki, a celebrated director of photography who wowed with "Gravity" and "The Revenant," turns in a film that seems very brown and undynamic.

Russell, the director of such taut dramas as "Three Kings" and "American Hustle," has clearly vanished here. You can almost hear the collective rejoinder from the real city of Amsterdam: Why'd you do us dirty, man?





sugar sprinkles, placed in small dish; jelly

beans; candy corns.

Place popcorn in bowl; In saucepan over medium heat, melt butter. Stir marshmallows into butter until melted. Stir in gelatin powder.

Pour mixture over popcom and stir. Shape popcom into ovals. Flatten one oval and squeeze one end to form "skull". Place on parchment-lined baking sheet.

Press two gumballs into each skull for "eyes." Press candy com to form "teeth." Trim candy strips for "hair." Sprinkle sprinkles. Allow "zombies" to set 20 minutes before wrapping individually in plastic wrap.

The process works by using an electric tattooing device. The professional will create very small dots to recreate the appearance of normal hair follicles. By using different shades of black, the small dots mirror the shadow you would normally see on your scalp.



What most people wonder at this point is, does it hurt? There will likely be some pain or discomfort but if you have a high pain tolerance, it may not be that bad. The professional will use a topical solution to numb the area.

You can ask the practitioner about what to expect during the initial consultation. After that, they will tell you how many sessions you will need and the approximate length.

They will also give you instructions on how to care for your scalp before treatment,

between treatments, and after treatments have been completed.

The benefit of this treatment is that it is a long term solution. Results last for up to eight years. The cost varies, but each treatment usually costs between \$400 and \$1,000. It can be used for men or women and when completed by a dedicated professional, the results are incredible. Finasteride

Finasteride is an oral medication for hair loss. It is used to stop hair loss or prevent hairlines from further receding. It is a prescription pill taken once a day.

It may take up to six months for the medication to work, and stopping treatment will likely result in resuming hair loss. It is non-invasive and easy to take.

Finasteride is generally safe, but if you have concerns you should talk to your doctor or a medical professional.

Red-Light Treatment

A hair transplant works by moving hair follicles from areas of the scalp with hair to areas that do not have as much hair. It is fairly complicated, but the results are natural-looking. It may require a few treatments to complete the hair transplant and it may be painful. Hair transplant surgery is expensive but it is a long term solution to hair loss. There may also be some scarring as a result of the hair transplant. Using micropigementaion can actually reduce the appearance of scarring from a hair transplant as well. 



Just recently "language has been removed from the Medicare Coverage Issues Manual stating that obesity is not an illness. 

SMART FABRICS AND WEARABLE ELECTRONICS

The Future of Clothing

Intelligent" or "smart" clothing is part of an exciting technology that involves building computing, connectivity, and sensing abilities into materials people are comfortable wearing. Some of the latest products are very fashionable, lightweight, and look no different than other clothes. In some cases, the electronic circuits that make up the brains of the wearable computers and sensors are sewn in. In others, the circuits and other components are literally built from conductive yarn and thread that makes up the clothing.

Right now, as devices get smaller, we often find ourselves with a different electronic device in each pocket. Each technological advance shrinks these devices and integrates them with one another. It's only logical that as these portable devices that connect us, we can eventually find ways to integrate right into the clothing we wear.

There are actually three distinct types of smart clothing:

Passive Smart: Where the clothing "reads" or senses the environment or something about the person wearing the clothing. Examples include built-in GPS, clothing-integrated baby breathing monitors, and clothing that gives feedback about potential changes in weather.

Active Smart: Where clothing not only senses the environment, but reacts to it. Examples include: Clothing that changes density depending on the temperature, jackets that store solar energy to charge cell phones and cameras, and even built-in sensors that can guide pinpoint massage to a wearer depending on his or her level of stress.

Active Very Smart: Where clothing has built in computing and or intelligent sensing. Examples include sleeves that function as keyboards, clothing that can function like a powerful calculator, and shirts that can store information through a built-in fabric keyboard and send it via Bluetooth.

Other classifications of intelligent clothing include "phase change" and "shape memory" materials. Phase change materials change aspects such as their density in reaction to the environment, in order to increase comfort or functionality. These clothes might become denser when it is cold and more porous when it is hot. Shape memory materials can change from a temporary deformed shape back to an original shape.

In the future, all of us might be wearing intelligent clothing that senses medical problems, gives the ability to charge electronic devices while on the go, and even allows for basic computing.
