

# Year of the Violin

### featuring violinist Fiona Shea

You are in for a night of beautiful music when San Fernando Valley Symphony Orchestra and founding Music Director and Conductor James Domine present the Year of the Violin featuring violinist Fiona Shea. The program includes Weber - Overture to "Oberon," Liszt, Les Preludes, Bruch. Violin Concerto #1 in G minor, and Domine -Violin Concerto #2 in B minor and a World Premiere Inaugural Performance.

Featured violinist Fiona Shea is currently pursuing a Bachelor of Music degree at the Colburn Conservatory, where she studies violin performance with Professor Robert Lipsett. She has appeared as a concerto soloist with the Mesquite, Waco, Conroe, Kingsville, and Abilene Symphonies in Texas as well as with orchestras in Jacksonville, IL,

Interlochen, MI, and Pacific Symphony as part of their "Symphony in the Cities" series.

She has also been featured as one of the soloists in Colburn's 2019 Concerto Showcase and has had opportunities to play in masterclasses with artists including Ray Chen, Stefan Jackiw, and Hilary Hahn. She received a Bronze

Medal in the Junior Division of the 2017 Fischoff Competition, as a member of the Aurielle Quartet, and was a member of the 2016 Class of Texas Young Masters by the Texas Commission on the Arts.

Fiona comes from a musical background. Both of her parents play - her



"The best part about playing music is

the entire process," she says. "I like starting a piece from scratch and getting to work on it. Then ultimately getting to share the music with an audience. There's something special to me about spending so much time with a piece."

At Year of the Violin, Fiona will be performing the Bruch Violin Concerto and Domine's Violin

Concerto #2. She loves to perform anything classical, from chamber to orchestral.

Fiona's music career is taking off as a soloist. "I'm enjoying the options that are coming my way to be able to play with an orchestra," she says. "That's my goal - to

Fiona will be playing two different concertos in one concert - a first for her. "I'll be playing both the Bruch and Mr. Domine's concerto," she says. "Just getting to play those in the same concert is going to be very exciting."

# ON SCREEN

### DEAR EVAN HANSEN

Filled with a murderer's row of talented musical actors singing their hearts out, Dear Evan Hansen is an ode to sincerity even while telling a tale of a insincere protagonist. Stephen Chbosky's previous adaptation, Wonder, was essentially about the choice between being nice and being kind, and this film plays in a similar sandbox. The film offers empathy to all its characters, even some who may not deserve it, offering every player a chance to sing their feelings and make a case as to why they matter. That it's in service of a story that could have easily been a dark comedy, and is a tricky balancing act. There is grace in its attempt.

In the film's introductory song, the first thing you'll notice is that 28-year-old Platt looks a little old to be playing a high schooler, and Platt has a killer set of pipes. The age difference between himself and, say, Kaitlyn Dever (she turns 25 in December) is far smaller than, say, Maitreyi Ramakrishnan (19) and Darren Barnet (30) in Netflix's Never Have I Ever. There are moments where Evan's isolation is enhanced by the visual discrepancy, and others where it looks like a spin-off of Jaume Collet-Serra's Orphan. I'm not going to argue the filmmakers shouldn't have

found a more youthful-looking 22-year-old, but it's only a deal-breaker if you let it be.

Based on the 2016 Tony-winning Broadway show Dear Evan Hansen is almost a challenge to a critical establishment that claims to want new entertainments even as it prefers to snark. Dear Evan Hansen is a movie about a single set of characters underdoing a singular journey. The movie concerns Evan (Platt), who suffers from social anxiety and the loneliness that comes with being alone in high school. Through circumstances that make a grim Rube Goldberg-level sense, a mocking signature on his cast and a stolen letter to himself creates a fiction when that thief dies by suicide, leaving the young man's grieving parents to think that he and Evan were friends.

Steven Levenson's adaptation of his show creates an unlikely scenario where young Evan doesn't invent this fiction, but instead has his initial denials ignored by an anguished family and goes along with what he thinks will be a "okay, just this once and be done with it" façade. Some of the broad strokes as a fiction concerning the death of a high schooler becomes a cultural event into which everyone imprints their feelings.



This film notes the social good that decent, people get from believing this falsehood. It condemns how society performatively latches onto a "faith in humanity restored" blip in time before moving on. We don't need to be told that folks have stopped caring, as a shot of the late student's locker decorated with dead roses is enough. The progression of Evan's lie, from an awkward dinner with the late Conner's parents to fabricated emails to a big speech in front of the school, has a grueling Venus flytrap quality, where Evan is less attempting to prolong the con than patronizing interested parties just one more time. Just when Evan thinks he's out, he gets pulled back in.

In word and in song the picture doesn't let Evan off the moral hook. It expects its audience not to require a yellow highlighter. The supporting cast all get their moments of anger and grief sans judgment. The film expects you to understand that Amandla Stenberg being cast as a secretly medicated overachiever always needing to appear on-task is not simple race-blind casting. Amy Adams crushes a challenging role as a grieving mother, while Dever is terrific as Conner's sister Zoe. The latter resents now being defined by the actions of her long-troubled older brother.

# THE GUILTY

7 here Gustav Moller brought a Scandanavian chill to his film Den skyldige, a thriller about a 911 operator trying to weave through a mystery following a call from a kidnapped woman, the pairing of director Antoine Fuqua and writer Nic Pizzolato bring heat to The Guilty, its English-language remake. This take is set in an ablaze LA, its emergency services overwhelmed by a fire, displayed on televisions in front of those manning the phones. Ash rains from the sky and the smoke irritates everything, including the lungs of Joe Baylor (Jake Gyllenhaal), a disgraced cop who finds himself working the lines while he waits to go to trial for an offense committed in the line of duty. He's sweaty and gaunt, coughing in the bathroom, collecting himself for what should be a final shift. How wrong he is.

Pizzolato renders his lead into a firecracker, ready to pop off at anybody, be it a caller who gets robbed by prostitutes or a reporter from the LA Times asking for his side of the story. His attitude conceals pain

and fear hindering the decent person, the good dad he wants to be or the not-shitty ex-husband he wishes he were, that only the right situation can challenge him to overcome. In the middle of this ashift, he's forced to confront all of it when he picks up the phone and hears a shaky voice talk to him like as if he were her kid. The woman's name is Emily (Riley Keough), and she's trying to communicate with him by pretending that Joe's her daughter so as to not aggravate her kidnapper. From then on, Joe swears that he's going to save this woman, whatever it takes.

Yet, Joe comes to realize the depths of the institutional rot that he's been a part of, and how little good intentions matter when it comes to mobilizing a response to save lives. His conflicts with the other dispatchers, the CHP, and his former police Sergeant begin to roll together, and, when combined with the situation are trickling in with every phone call from Emily, Joe starts to come apart. Gyllenhaal is an aggressively earnest actor, and as the script strips him of his defenses. One could compare it to radio



or theater and, indeed, the single-location drama can often be rightfully accused of all that, but the distance between the audience and Joe's anguish is immediate.

That's not to say that the director doesn't bring other aspects of the film to life, and there are some fantastic bits of color-contrast. We leave the dispatch room and follow movement under the ash-choked sky,, though those scenes are few. There are a few missteps as well, such as the ending, which has an element of hoariness. But with the array of voice talent assembled and misery seeping through, The Guilty is a pretty worthy remake.





# Clearing up the confusion between good cholesterol and bad cholesterol

If you're wondering about good and bad cholesterol and what they mean for your health, you're not alone. Even people with the highest risk of heart disease may have a hard time understanding the connection between high cholesterol levels and heart health and what they can do to lower their levels.

Here we'll describe the differences between good and bad cholesterol to help you make the best decisions for your health going forward.

What is cholesterol?

Cholesterol is a waxy substance your body needs to make healthy cells, hormones and vitamins. However, too much cholesterol can raise your risk of heart disease, stroke and other health problems. Nearly one in three American adults has higher than the recommended cholesterol levels.

Cholesterol moves through the body on lipoproteins, which are a combination of fat and protein. What we refer to as "good" and "bad" cholesterol are actually different types of lipoproteins. High-density lipoproteins (HDLs), which are the good kind, help

carry cholesterol out of the body.

Low-density lipoproteins (LDLs) enter the walls of the arteries (the tubes that carry blood), causing them to become hard and clogged with plaque. When that plaque builds up, the heart has to work harder to get blood to the rest of the body, including the brain. This increases the risk of heart attack and stroke, two of the major causes of death in the U.S. LDLs are what we call the "bad cholesterol."

There's also another type of bad cholesterol: very low density lipoprotein, which contributes to the buildup of plaque as well. Since HDL clears out cholesterol, raising your HDL numbers usually lowers your LDL numbers, which is a win-win for heart health.

Check your levels

When you get your cholesterol levels checked (which adults should do at least every five years and even more often with age), you'll get a series of numbers:

- Total cholesterol: This should be under 200-240.
- HDL level: Recommended HDL levels are 40 mg/dL for men over 20 years old and 50 mg/dL for women.
- LDL level: Adults should have LDL levels of less than 100 mg/dL.
- VLDL level: This should be less than 30 mg/dL.

Your results will also show another important number: your triglyceride level. Triglycerides are another form of fat in your blood that raises your risk of heart disease. You want this number under 200 mg/dL, or better yet, under 150 mg/dL.




Other data supports similar findings.

# TOP 5 CAT HAIRBALL QUESTIONS ANSWERED

Your cat is gagging and spitting up. Could he or she have hairballs? Most cats experience hairballs at some point in their lives, and usually it's simply a minor annoyance. Below we answer five common questions about hairballs, including what they are, why cats get them and steps you can take to help prevent them

1. What are hairballs?

Cats groom themselves by licking their fur which can cause them to swallow loose hair. Usually, the hair goes right through the cat's gastrointestinal tract and comes out in the stool. Sometimes, hair collects in the cat's stomach and forms into hairballs — resulting in coughing, gagging and ultimately a regurgitated fur mass on the floor. Cats generally feel better after getting rid of a hairball.

2. My cat coughs and hacks. Could my cat have hairballs?

A cat who hacks for more than a month likely has more than a hairball. Longhaired cats, such as Persians, tend to get hairballs more frequently than shorthaired cat breeds, but cats do not "hack" or "cough" up hairballs continuously. Technically, cats "spit up" or vomit hairballs. If hairball diets, gels or ointments do not curb the problem another issue could be causing your cat to cough and hack, which should warrant a call to your veterinarian.

3. Does hairball medicine work?

Medicated hairball gel or paste contains mineral oil or petroleum jelly that is not absorbed in your cat's system, but adds lubrication so the hairball will pass easily. Hairball treatments should not be given with food in order to avoid interfering with your cat's regular diet.

4. Are hairballs to blame for my cat's vomiting?

Hairballs are a common cause of vomiting and also can contribute to constipation. However, vomiting immediately after eating can be a sign that your cat eats too quickly or perhaps the type of food (for instance, dry versus canned) is irritating your cat's gastrointestinal tract.

Cats can also vomit from either a metabolic problem (like renal failure or hyperthyroidism) or a



gastrointestinal problem. Blood and urine tests can rule out common metabolic causes of vomiting. If you suspect gastrointestinal causes, try changing your cat's food to a bland, non-irritating diet or a hypoallergenic diet. If your cat continues to vomit, ask your vet if an ultrasound or endoscopy would be beneficial to determine the cause of the problem.

5.Can cat hairballs be prevented?

Hairballs in cats aren't entirely avoidable, but the following steps can help you minimize the problem Brush your cat regularly. The more fur you can remove, the less is likely to end up in your cat's stomach.

Give your cat hairball ointment two or three times a week. Most cats enjoy the taste and consider it a treat

Consider feeding your cat food designed to reduce hairballs. Hairball formula food contains higher amounts of fiber, which helps push

intestinal contents through your cat's system. This type of food also contains specific enzymes that help prevent hairballs from forming in the stomach in the first place.

Be sure to contact your veterinarian if your cat is vomiting frequently as it may be a sign of a more serious condition.

### **NEWS OF THE WEIRD**

Remember Bernie Sanders' look at the 2021 inauguration? Cozy parka, heavy knitted gloves? You too can pull off the Bernie look for Halloween, The Boston Globe reported. For just \$85, partygoers can don the "Once Again Asking Costume Set" from Dolls Kill. It includes the coat, mittens and surgical mask. Sen. Sanders' office even commented: "If fans of Sen. Sanders' mittens are looking for a real scare this Halloween, they should see how hard the wealthy and world's biggest corporations are fighting to stop Congress from finally addressing the long-neglected needs of the working class," said spokesperson Mike Casca.

#### Bright Idea

File this one under Marketing Ideas Gone Wrong: Speech Academy Asia in Singapore planted clowns outside multiple primary schools in early September in an effort to persuade students to enroll in public-speaking courses, The Straits Times reported. In response, principals and parents urged students to stay away from strangers, including the clowns. Kelvin Tan, the director of the academy, apologized for alarming people. He explained that "road show" employees were told to put on "cute mascot" costumes, but he wasn't aware they'd be wearing clown getups. "Maybe the clowns were too scary. It's wrong and we won't do it again," he said.

#### New World Order

The divorce of Valeria Udalova and Danila Medvedev, former co-owners of cryonics company KrioRus in Moscow, Russia, has turned ugly as they battle over 81 bodies of KrioRus clients, Slate reported. On Sept. 7, Udalova reportedly broke into a cryostorage facility that is under Medvedev's control and loaded containers with dead bodies onto a truck, causing damage and spilling liquid nitrogen in the process. Both parties now own separate cryonics businesses, but police continue to investigate who controls the 81 bodies, which in the meantime rest at Medvedev's facility.

-- An elderly woman in Okemos, Michigan, moved to a nursing home, and an auction company was hired to clear out her home, MLive.com reported on Sept. 22. One of the

items found by Epic Auctions and Estate Sales' Brad Stoecker was a 5-foot-tall granite headstone with the name Peter J. Weller on the front. Apparently, the woman's family didn't know the origin of the stone, saying they used the reverse side of it to make fudge. Stoecker donated the stone to the Friends of Lansing's Historic Cemeteries, but a genealogist was unable to find any surviving family members of Weller, who died in 1849. However, they did track down his grave, which had been moved in 1875. That's probably when the gravestone was lost, experts believe. Cemetery preservationists restored the stone to Weller's current resting place and repaired and cleaned those of his family members nearby.

-- Some students at Piedmont High School in Union County, North Carolina, were upset after a sign reading WHITE was placed on a drinking fountain at the school, The Charlotte Observer reported on Sept. 23. A Snapchat video of the sign circulated on social media, and parents became upset, prompting a response from Principal Dylan Stamey, who said he had investigated and the placement of the sign "was not intentional." "During practice, a cheer sign was left just outside the gym on the floor, and it was picked up and placed on a water fountain. We apologize if anyone was offended," he said.

As a 48-year-old man pumped gas in St. Louis on the morning of Sept. 21, a woman approached and said she and her son needed a ride to her mother's house. He agreed, KSDK-TV reported, but when they arrived at the home, the woman reportedly grabbed the keys from the ignition, and her 11-year-old started pistol-whipping him in the head. The woman then dragged the victim out of his car and sped away with her son. Police are still looking for the carjacker. [

On Sept. 17, at a penguin colony near Simonstown, South Africa, 63 endangered African penguins were killed by a swarm of bees, CNN reported. South African National Parks issued a statement saying that the "deaths occurred suddenly sometime between Thursday afternoon and Friday morning." Examinations revealed that "all the penguins had multiple bee stings," many of which were around the birds' eyes, which one expert called a "fluke."
