YOU'VE HEARD IT BEFORE. LA'S THE LAND OF FRUITS AND NUTS. WE'RE NOT TALKING EDIBLES. BUT BEING ORDINARY ISN'T ANY FUN. EMBRACE THE CREATIVITY. ENJOY THE WILD, WACKY – AND WONDERFUL – ATTRACTIONS THAT ONLY LA CAN INSPIRE.

Crazy Art

Have an electrifying time at the Museum of Neon Art (www.neonmona.org) in Glendale! Remember The Brown Derby restaurant's neon derby? It's here! And those neon diving beauties in swim caps from the 1950s? They're here, too. In fact, so much neon art from the 1920s through the '70s, and modern neon art is here, MONA, as it's affectionately called, is acknowledged to be the only museum in the world devoted exclusively to art in electric media. Exhibiting electric and kinetic fine art, and historic neon signs for more than 30 years. Enjoy the permanent collection – Derby included – and new exhibits. Neon artist "Oliver Nowlin: Lightning's Lung" continues through August 27. Open Thursday through Sunday, noon – 7 p.m. Adults, \$10; ages 65 and up, \$8; ages 12 and under, free.

Tucked away in the Hollywood Hills – on the way to the Hollywood Sign – the Hollywood Sculpture Garden (www.hollywoodsculpturegarden.com) provides an intriguing experience among more than 100 one-of-a-kind avant-garde sculptures, statuettes and outdoor paintings, many for use with 3D glasses – paired with breathtaking views of all Los Angeles. Founded by Dr. Robby Gordon on his hillside estate, the photo ops are great among the modern and contemporary works in bronze, blown glass, carved marble and granite, rocks and minerals assemblage, metal assemblage, forged metal, bended metal, and

paintings. Each by well-established and up-and-coming artists from the US, Canada, Italy, Belgium, Argentina, Chile, Mexico, Sweden, and Zimbabwe. Admission is by appointment only. Or sign up for the reception on October 7, from 5 – 8 p.m. Donations accepted.

The Watts Towers (www.wattstowers.org)! We take them for granted, but they are among LA most funky



artworks. Created by Italian artist-immigrant Simon Rodia from 1921 to 1954, "Nuestro Pueblo," as he named them, number 17 interconnected sculptural towers, architectural structures, and individual sculptural features and mosaics in his original backyard. Using steel covered with mortar, Rodia embellished each with decorative finishings of mosaic, tiles, glass, clay, shells, porcelain, and rock. No welding. Rodia wired rebars together, then wrapped each joint with wire mesh and hand packed it with mortar and his mosaic surface. The International Conference of Museum Curators named Rodia's Towers "a paramount work of folk art of the 20th century." They're also on the National Register of Historic Places, a National Historic Landmark, a State of California Historic

Monument, and State of California Historic Park. Tours are free. Offered on Thursday and Friday, 11 a.m. – 3 p.m.

A current LA artistic couple is equally skilled at transforming their home into a work of art. The Mosaic Tile House (www.cheripann.com) in Venice explodes with tile designs covering nearly every square inch, inside and out. Recent additions include an Alice in Wonderland wall featuring a 3-D caterpillar, the Queen of Hearts, a rabbit hole, and the White Rabbit. Plus, they have a gift shop. Open Saturday, noon – 3 p.m. Reservations only at mosaictilehouse@mac.com. Adults, \$20; ages 65 and up, \$15; ages 12 and under, and 90 and above are free.

MISSION: IMPOSSIBLE

Dead Reckoning, Part One

ondering if you should choose to accept the latest "Mission: Impossible" entry?
On the first day cameras were rolling for "Mission: Impossible – Dead Reckoning, Part One," Cruise drove a motorcycle off an actual 4,000-foot Norwegian cliff and then parachuted down. The least you can do to repay him is watch his movie.

If you do give in, you're in for a treat. It's got facemasks being ripped off, a car chase through Rome, a shoot-out in the desert, a sword fight on a bridge and an intense, runaway train sequence.

"This is getting exciting," one character says early on.

Christopher McQuarrie returns for the third time as director — and he's brought back love interest Rebecca Ferguson, comic relief Simon Pegg and Ving Rhames, Vanessa Kirby as The White Widow and Henry Czerny as Eugene Kittridge.

Newcomers include Esai Morales as a bad baddie and Pom Klementieff as his psychotic aide. Hayley Atwell also makes her debut, playing a master thief and possible romantic partner for Cruise's Ethan Hunt.

The bad guy isn't a guy, it's a haywire conscious artificial intelligence that has infiltrated every nation's computer systems.

This AI can foul up every digital device . It's "an enemy that is everywhere and nowhere." The filmmakers aren't too keen in specifics, leaving it an existential threat and giving it the nickname, The Entity.



"Dead Reckoning," as the "Part One" is another action franchise going epic with several-part arcs. The key is sought by Cruise, our thief/love interest, a U.S. Special Operations team, Morales' Gabriel and arms dealer The White Widow. It soon gets swiped, pickpocketed and seized, jumping from owner to owner.

What's so special about this key? The AI needs it and one estimate of its worth is \$100 million, "The fate of the world rests on finding whatever the key unlocks," we are told.

If other "Mission: Impossible" outings have felt that Hunt is robotic, this time filmmakers allow humanity to peek through. Cruise shows delightful annoyance at having to sit in the passenger seat as his car careens through Rome. He also shows a tender side in Venice as he cuddles Ferguson on a gondola.

Speaking of that car chase in Rome — we get the delightful image of Cruise and Atwell handcuffed together in a tiny, vintage yellow Fiat 500.

"Is anyone NOT chasing us?" she asks.

All the parties come together at one of those big, elegant Eurotrash dance parties that only Hollywood seems to love.

Then the movie culminates with Cruise's motorcycle leap, a fight sequence on a steam train and a derailment that forces the good guys to climb through railcar after railcar.

Are you not going to accept this mission? Tom Cruise basically flew for you. It would be rude to leave him hanging.

he "Insidious" franchise folds back on itself for the fifth installment, returning to its roots. Patrick Wilson, Ty Simpkins, Rose Byrne and Andrew Astor reunite for "Insidious: The Red Door," and whether or not you'll want to push this door open may depend on how much of a completist you are. Laving it shut may be just fine.

The movie takes place nine years after 2013's "Insidious: Chapter 2," and the heroic Lambert family is not doing well. Dad (Wilson) and mom (Byrne) are divorced and their college-aged son, Dalton (Ty Simpkins), pretty much hates dad.

The push-pull of fathers and sons is a prominent theme here, but the roots of this unhappiness may have to do with the fact that they have suppressed memories of wrestling with demons.

The Further is described as "a world far beyond our own, yet it's all around us, a place without time as we know it, a dark realm filled with the tortured souls of the dead, a place not meant for the living."

Dad and son share a special gift — the ability to astral project, or leave their bodies and drift into other worlds. But the cost is high — the son was in a coma for a year and a demon possessed dad. Memories of that were supposed to be wiped away.

Dad and son in the new installment gradually unlock The Further and navigate it, but the movie alls apart into incoherence and the use of jumpscares of shocking images.

It's a pity because Wilson not only acts, he also makes a strong directorial debut and even sings over the end credits.

The screenplay by franchise newcomer Scott Teems feels more like fan fiction, with its loving nods to items associated with the franchise.



In reality, Byme and Astor have very little screen time and it is Wilson and Simpkins who are the stars.

There are some new touches, most notably a fright-fest in an MRI machine, an already intimate procedure in a tight place. Chunks of "Insidious: Chapter 2" — the final scene and a crucial fight — are reused liberally, and actor Sinclair Daniel adds comic relief and some sanity but her story is

abandoned unsatisfactorily at the end. Too many bows are attached to the movie's final moments as well, reunions not earned or coherent.

If the "Insidious" franchise is your jam, by all means go and see the original Fab Four of the Lambert family battle hollow-eyed demons for perhaps the last time. But for everyone else, why not let the past stay in the past?

HOW DO I BEGOME AN ONLINE DETECTIVE?

he route taken to become an online detective will depend on what services you plan to offer. In most cases, you will need to become licensed in private investigation in the area in which you live, and perhaps in additional areas where you intend to do business. Services you offer online may include criminal background checks, online history reports, and person location services. You may also choose to combine Internet detective work with more traditional private investigation.

In order to become licensed in private investigation, you will likely be required to either attend a training school or academy, or apprentice

for a practicing investigator. Requirements for becoming licensed vary depending on location, so you should always check into regulations in your area and in any area where you would like to offer your services. In some cases, you may only have to study and take a test or apply for a license with no schooling necessary. In other areas, full college training will be required.

Before you become an online detective, look into any additional licensing you may need. This may include gaining a business license if you intend to be self-employed. If you find work with an existing agency, no further licensing may be needed.

Most often, in order to become an online detective, you will acquire specialized software that makes accessing hard to find files and information easier. These programs may be linked to personnel files, criminal records, and additional information not available via regular search engines. In most cases, you will have to pay for this software, but it will prove invaluable as you go about doing your job.

You can go about finding clients for your own online detective business by advertising on online boards, and by creating a website and marketing it using various methods. In many cases, it is a good idea to network with



those who would be most likely to use your services. Calling local businesses is another good idea, since often they need to conduct background checks on potential employees.

If you would rather become an online detective for an established private investigator or online detective agency, call around and find out who is hiring and what training they look for in an employee. Mention any past experience you have, and craft a resume highlighting any work you have done in researching or investigation. Use instances of having to do these things in your everyday life if you do not have professional experience, and include any schooling you have obtained.



Place the freezer bag in a clean tall drinking glass.

Combine the orange juice, tequila and orange extract in a liquid measuring cup; stir.

Place a funnel into the top of the freezer pop bag.

Slowly pour the liquid into the bag. NOTE: The liquid should reach the 'fill line' on the bag but no higher.

Pour the grenadine through the funnel into the liquid. It will create a color gradient with redder toward the bottom.

Seal and freeze the freezer pop upright in the freezer until fully frozen.

To eat: cut the top of the freezer pop bag just below the zipper seal and serve.

Clean Your Grill with a Cut Onion

Forget those fancy grilling tools—to clean the grit off the grate of your grill, all you need to do is halve an onion and run it up and down each rung. The acidity will cut right



Soak Your Skewers

There's almost nothing tastier than meat or veggie kebabs. The next time you're grilling up a bunch, keep the skewers from getting scorched by submerging them in water for an hour (or two) before you use them. This will prevent the skewers from drying out, burning, and starting to smoke before you're ready to remove 'em from the grill.



through any residual grease and grime, plus it will add a subtle onion flavor to whatever you cook next. (It's best to do this before the grill is hot.)

Check Propane Levels with Hot Water
It can be tough to determine how much

simple trick? Heat up some water (FYI, it

Light Coals with an Egg Carton

The one big drawback of grilling with briquettes is having to wait for them to heat up. Speed up the process by taking an empty cardboard (not Styrofoam!) egg carton and placing one Match Light briquette in every slot. Think of it as DIY kindling—you'll be grilling in no time.

Throw Herbs Over the Charcoal

Simply presoak the chips in water for a couple of hours before adding them to the bread pan. Then, cover it in foil and use a sharp knife (or a skewer) to puncture the surface so the smoke can escape. Put your smoker on the grill over one heating element, put the meat on a different rack, and close the lid. That's it! Yes - you can try these at home! Enjoy.

Tent Your Food with Tin Foil

After your meat—whether burgers, steaks, or chops—has been cooked, take it off the grill, then mold a piece of tin foil into a loose tent shape and rest it over your meat for about five minutes. This simple trick helps to contain moisture and steam so the juices in the meat will meld together.



ill Geer Theatricum Botanicum continues its 50th Anniversary Summer Season with Queen Margaret's Version of Shakespeare's War of the Roses, an edit of Shakespeare's history plays — Henry VI Parts I, II and III and Richard III — compiled by artistic director Ellen Geer. Performances continue through October 1.

Dubbed the "British Game of Thrones" and Shakespeare's "First Boxed Set" by British director Trevor Nunn, War of the Roses follows 30 years of bitter infighting between the Lancaster and Plantagenet dynasties as they battle

for crown of England. Geer puts the focus on the women in court as they watch the bloody wars take the lives of their fathers, husbands and sons.

"It's so like today," says Geer. "The intrigue of the court is just like Congress and the fight for the White House. It's all about

who deserves what and who did what to whom. All done for political rise and wealth."

Playing the men are Roman Guastaferro as King Henry IV; Emoria Weidner as King Henry VI; Franc Ross as the Duke of Gloucester, protector of the realm; Max Lawrence as Richard, Duke of York (father of Edward IV and Richard



III); Jon Sprik as both the Duke of Suffolk and Richard III; Tim Halligan as the Duke of Somerset; Gerald C. Rivers as the Duke of Buckingham; and Christopher Wallinger as Cardinal Beaufort. The large cast also features Charlie

Burg; Sara Carpenter; Ben Church; Rhett Curry; Cole Dechant, Emelie Dechant, Julius Geer-Polin; Dylan Greer; Colin Guthrie; Emerson Haller; Christopher Wei Fu Hemandez; Michael Kendrick; Andrew Klein; Tariq Mieres; Nations; Daniel Ramirez, Quinlynn Scheppner; Anthony Soliz, Sky Wahl; Aralyn Wilson; and Elliott Gray Wilson.

Queen Margaret's Version of Shakespeare's War of the Roses will run every weekend with Shakespeare's Macbeth and A Midsummer Night's Dream and A Perfect Ganesh by Terrence McNally. Theatricum will perform all four plays in repertory.

Events taking place include comedy improv with Theatricum's troupe, Off the Grid (July 27, Aug. 31, Sept. 28); a 50th Anniversary Gala (Aug. 5); Under the Oaks salon series (Sept. 8 - Sept. 29); Americana Harvest Festival that includes a special performance of The Woody Guthrie Story (Oct. 8); and the company's annual Holiday Family Faire (Dec. 9).

Theatricum's beginnings can be traced to the early 1950s when Will Geer opened a theater for blacklisted actors and folk singers. Today, two outdoor amphitheaters are situated in the natural canyon ravine, where audiences are able to relax and enjoy.

Dee Snider Rocker, Actor, DJ And Now Writer

ee Snider is taking a novel approach to life after rock stardom. The former singer for '80s glam rock band Twisted Sister just released his first novel, 'Frats,' about the madness, cruelty and alcohol and testosterone-fueled bravado of the 1970s high school fraternity scene on Long Island, New York.

His debut as a novelist follows his previous stints as a radio disc jockey, TV voiceover artist, Broadway actor, horror film writer and of course the drag-wearing face of the band known for the hits "We're Not Gonna Take It" and "I Wanna Rock."

"Always something new and interesting; that's key to me," Snider said. "I want to feel challenged."

He got the writing bug coming up with the script for the band's breakthrough 1984 video for

"We're Not Gonna Take It" in which a father berates his son, who then morphs into Snider and engages in cartoonish takedowns of dear old dad.

"I started to teach myself how to write," he said. "In 1984, everybody was out partying; I was in the dressing room or in the hotel working on writing. I'm not a singer who decided to write a book — or had someone write one for him. I've been laboring away, honing the craft.

"I'm not Vince Neil," Snider said. "I'm the guy you saw in Washington (where he testified before the U.S. Senate defending heavy metal, a guy who can put together a sentence, and express himself."

In his autobiography "Shut Up and Give Me The Mic," Snider learned about the bane of many writers: editors. His editor wanted 315 pages; Snider had 700 written.

"They chopped it in half," he said. "I call it 'killing babies.' You have a great section for a book, but you have to remove something."

"Frats," which Snider says he wrote without assistance, follows the lives of friends who navigate the minefields posed by first boys, the pressure to conform and the isks taken in the name of belonging. Main character, Bobby Kovacs, is loosely drawn from Snider's own high school experiences.

There's even a few Easter eggs that Twisted Sister fans may spot: The fictional reporter who wrote a story about a heinous crime integral to the plot is named Mark Segall, taking the first name of Twisted Sister's bassist, Mark "The Animal" Mendoza, and the second name of guitarist Jay Jay French, born John Segall.

The band playing the prom is named Dusk; Kovacs notes the singer went on to become famous. Dusk was Snider's real-life high school band.

Snider, 68, made headlines when his support of a tweet by Kiss singer Paul Stanley critical of juveniles undergoing sex reassignment surgery led Snider's planned appearance at the San Francisco Pride parade to be canceled.

"I saw what Paul said, and I agreed about saying kids aren't ready to make those decisions," Snider

> said. He said he told SF Pride, "I think I should not attend. Look, we disagree, I'm in support of you, I don't want to cause you problems, let me bow out.

"You can't afford to be alienating supporters, people who

stand with you, sing with you, march with you, just because they don't agree with every single thing you say," he said. "I am a supporter of the trans community and the gay community. I dressed in drag and stood tall, and inspired millions of young men and women to be themselves."

He wrote on Twitter that "I am open to educating myself so I can be a better ally."

Suzanne Ford, executive director of SF Pride, welcomed that declaration.

"Like any ally, we're glad that Dee wants to continue learning about the issues that affect the transgender community," Ford said. "As a trans woman, I can tell you that no two stories are alike. This isn't a black-and-white conversation, which is why educating the public is so critical."

Twisted Sister retired in 2016, and there are no plans to revive the band, though Snider admits it would be tempting to go onstage again in makeup and costumes in one of the numerous states that have banned drag shows attended by children "as a poke in the eye."

Disc Golf Destinations In Southern California

f you love disc golf, these five courses are perfect. Send an entire day disc golfing in the mountains, overlooking a lake, or at a local park. La Mirada Disc Golf Course

The legendary La Mirada is everything you imagine when you think about disc golf in paradise: mild temperatures, a cool breeze, and plenty of palm trees.

La Mirada's two 18-hole courses, the Lakeside and Backside, are situated on rolling hills of manicured green grass.

"LaMi" is fair and forgiving with a mix of open and lightly wooded



fairways. A good roller game will go a long way to get you through the sycamore and pine trees.

The 520 foot Hole 4 on the Backside is one of the highlights. It's the only par 4 and the best drives require throwing over the out of bounds area to a green on a small island. Laying up to a safe space isn't always easy. When there's a headwind, errant drives could leave you too far away for your approach. Short approach shots and shanked putts could turn your

birdie or par into a snowman—a 10 during a tournament is not uncommon. Waller Pines Disc Golf Course

Waller Pines Disc Golf Course has 27 holes, most with four or five pin positions allowing you to play thousands of unique layouts. The terrain alternates between lush grass




with wide sightlines and sandy, pine needle-covered fairways cluttered with trees. Bring a large bag or cart full of discs because this course will test all of your skills from backhands to forehands and skip shots to sky hyzers.

Sky High Disc Golf Course

Throwing the first hole at Sky
High DGC is like taking that first steep
downhill run of the day on a snowboard.
If you don't go for it then you're likely
to end up face-planted in the snow
with your disc flying wide left, out of
bounds to the right, or even beyond the
basket and down the mountain. Though
closed during winter when it serves
its primary role as the Mountain High
(North) recreational resort, Sky High is
arguably the best place to play disc golf
around the Greater Los Angeles area.

Sky High is over 7,000 ft above sea level and one of the only places



in Southern California where you can play an Ice Bowl in the snow. Coyote Point at Lake Casitas

The par 54, 18-hole course is less than 6,000 feet long, but two rounds at Coyote Point will make you feel like you've played disc golf for the entire day. The downhill shot on Hole 1, 300-400 feet depending on pin position, can be dangerously windy. Poorly-thrown drives can fade hard left or turnover wide right requiring a very challenging second shot where twenty-foot putts become nail-biting testers.

Many of the fairways are open but there are plenty of technical lines with low-ceilings, canopies and natural obstacles to get in your way. You'll throw downhill on at least a third of the course including Hole 16. the top of the world signature hole, which is sometimes elevated on top of a boulder. The 18th and final hole plays back up a hill to the parking lot, but don't take this under 300 foot shot for granted-rolling down the right side of the hill could turn an easy par into a disappointing double bogie. Hart Park, Sharktooth Mountain & Suicide Flats

Two truly unique disc golf courses sit on 370 acres of land. Which one do you play first: the shorter course with lots of elevation change or the longer, flat course with water hazards and trees? Just make sure you bring hunch and cold drinks as you walk and hike up to 15,000 feet over 36 holes.

Shark Tooth Mountain is best played carrying backpack or bag as seven holes play uphill and the two downhill ones span a combined 1,200 feet from pads to pins. The hike up the mountain is well-rewarded with incredible views you'll see on no other disc golf couse in SoCal.

Suicide Flats is the perfect cart-friendly course. The challenges lie in the water hazards and the clusters of trees demanding low-level tunnel shots. Bring your most understable plastic if you want a chance at a birdie. Don't get carried away with the playing a ground game—an unintentional cut roller on hole 4 could result in a 6 or an 8. Some baskets are close to the edge of canals so bring back up discs, a disc retriever or even a pair of waders.

FISH TANK BASICS

A Simple Guide to Copepods and Amphipods

o you own a saltwater fish tank? Then you'll know that it is not uncommon to find tiny white bugs swimming around in your tank. There are quite a few things you should know about these critters.

Keep reading to learn more about copepods and amphipods that might be calling your aquarium home.

Copepods

These little sea bugs generally appear in your saltwater aquarium system when you have added live rock or sand. During their larvae and juvenile stages, they will most often be free-swimming



throughout the tank water. As they age into adults they will settle into the substrate of your tank.

Copepods can be found in all types of aquatic systems, from freshwater to saltwater, and are one of the many organisms that help make up animal plankton. These creatures help detritus, phytoplankton, and microzooplankton.

Amphipods

Amphipods are tiny little crustaceans that also enjoy eating the detritus found at the bottom of your fish tank, alongside the glass and even inside your filters. 



A Step By **Step Guide To Building** An ADU

hat Is an Accessory Dwelling Unit? This term refers to any small dwelling that's separate from the main house on a property. Some terms are granny flats, in-law suites, tiny houses, and garden

Detached ADUs

units separate from your main house.

Attached ADUs

Attached ADUs join onto your home. You can turn a basement, garage, or attic into an attached ADU.



Why Do You Want to Build an ADU?

The purpose of your ADU also affects construction time. Some of the main uses include: Office space; Home Gym: Artist's Studio; As a Guest Cottage.

Your budget as well as intentions for your ADU will impact size and design.

Factors Affecting Your Timeline

These are the steps involved: Arranging the finance for your ADU; Working out a design; Arranging floor plans for the design; Submitting plans; Getting approval from your city; Hiring an architect and contractor; Recording the City's Covenant Agreement.

Designing Your ADU

There's nothing to stop you from designing your ADU yourself. You can also get a contractor. You will need a professional architect to finalize the formal drawings to submit your design to your town planner. You'll also need to sign a form agreement with your architect. A professional architect shouldn't take more than a week to come up with a layout.

Compiling the Necessary Documents

Municipal regulations govern any construction. In some areas, it might not be legally possible to build an ADU in your backyard. Some common regulations are:

Restrictions on the number of dwellings allowed; Distance limitations regarding how close you can build; Height restrictions on new constructions; Size limits on ADU's; Parking regulations; Environmental by-laws.

There are two stages involved in getting your ADU through the approval process: Apply For Zoning

You may need to achieve zoning approval These backyard buildings are stand-alone before applying for a building permit. Others will allow you to apply for both simultaneously. These are the most common requirements for zoning: A site plan detailing the outline and dimensions of your property; A list of all property owners within 300 ft. of your ADU.

Apply for a Building Permit

If you're using a contractor or architect, you can get them to complete this for you. Some cities require additional permits. These include electrical and inspections. You can check where you need to go for these permits with local building officials.

Constructing Your ADU

Average construction time for different ADU's are as follows: Junior suite - four to eight weeks:



Stand-alone ADU – 15 to 24 weeks; Garage conversion - eight to sixteen weeks.

Final Steps

Take time to inspect your ADU and make a note of snags. Then go through this with your contractor and get them to carry out necessary changes. Once you're satisfied, schedule an appointment with city officials to conduct a final inspection. If they approve for occupation, you're good to go!

NEWS OF THE WEIRD

In 1973, Nissim Kahlon was living in a tent on a beach north of Tel Aviv, Israel, the Associated Press reported. He started scratching into a sandstone cliff wall along the beach, and eventually excavated a cave and moved in. Fifty years later, his created home is a sandcastle, with multiple floors, staircases, detailed mosaic floors and plumbing. But now Israel's Environmental Protection Ministry is moving to evict Kahlon, saying the structure is illegal and threatens the coastline. He said he first got a demolition order in 1974, but since then the government has left him alone, even connecting his home to the electrical grid. "I am not leaving here," Kahlon, 77, said. "I am ready for them to bury me here. I have no other home."

French President Emmanuel Macron now has the singular distinction of being the first French head of state to receive a body part in the mail, the Evening Standard reported. On July 10, a severed finger belonging to a "living human being" arrived at the Elysee Palace, where it was "initially put in a fridge where the police put their snacks," a source said. "This was to make sure it was preserved and could be analyzed as quickly as possible." The former owner of the digit was identified and given "full medical support," but it was unclear what the meaning behind the delivery was.

The Toronto Zoo has a favor to ask of visitors to Nassir the gorilla: Please don't show him photos or videos on your phone. Like any other 24-year-old primate, Nassir is "fascinated by videos, and screen time would dominate his life if he had it his way," according to the zoo's website. The Toronto Star reported that Maria Franke, director of wildlife conservation and welfare, is noticing the effect of visitors sharing their content. "It was causing him to be distracted and not interacting with the other gorillas ... He was just so enthralled with gadgets and phones and the videos." A sign now warns visitors: "Some content can be upsetting and affect their relationships and behavior within their family." Phones down, humans.

An 8-year-old boy faces multiple charges, including first-degree robbery, after he carjacked a vehicle at gunpoint on July 11 in Montgomery, Alabama, WSFA-TV reported. Officers tried to stop the car, but the little

driver wouldn't stop and later crashed into another car. A witness, "Snake" Knapp, said he saw the kid pick up two adults along the way. "I think parents just really need to know where their kids are, what their kids are doing," Knapp mused.

Doctors at the Wright-Patterson Medical Center near Dayton, Ohio, presented a case in the New England Journal of Medicine on July 6 that detailed a man whom they diagnosed with "hairy tongue." Gizmodo reported that the 64-year-old consulted with doctors when he developed a green, fuzzy layer on his tongue. He was prescribed antifungals, but they didn't help. Hairy tongue occurs when keratin causes a buildup of papillae, the tiny projections on the tongue. The man was directed to scrub his tongue with a toothbrush four times a day and stop smoking, and the green fuzz disappeared.

Lakewood, Colorado, police are searching for a serial panty thief, The Denver Gazette posted on July 6. The unknown suspect, described as having short black hair, a black goatee, dark eyes and a muscular build, allegedly lifts women's underwear from laundry rooms at the Lakewood Towers at Belmar apartments. Over the course of at least 26 incidents, he "has taken approximately \$4,881 worth of items," Lakewood police said. [Denver Gazette, 7/6/2023]

Animal Antics

- People living in the Travis Heights neighborhood of Austin, Texas, are thinking twice about venturing outdoors -- and it's not because of the heat. A red-shouldered hawk is terrorizing pedestrians -- to the point that U.S. mail delivery has been suspended in the area indefinitely, KTBC-TV reported. "Imagine walking out of your house and knowing that you're going to get punched in the back of the head by an animal with large talons," said Alfred Del Barrio. He said he avoided the hawk on a run because he saw its shadow. Nicole Netherton of the Travis Audubon Society said the hawk is protecting its young. "Trying to ignore them so that they can get their business and breeding done is probably the best advice," she said. State and federal laws protect migratory birds. Meanwhile, residents are asked to pick up their mail at a local post office until further notice.



HOW CELEBRITIES INFLUENCE TEENS AND WHY IT MATTERS

elebrities have a powerful impact on how teens view themselves. It's easy to underestimate how much celebrities influence teenage behavior.

Celebrities can have a positive influence. In fact, they can serve as role models. But famous people, can also provide unhealthy examples. In particular, body image and substance use is often detrimental.

Therefore, teenagers need guidance. Adults can engage with kids around media. In addition, they support how children process what they're seeing. Parents and teachers can use celebrities' stories as entry points into discussions about health and choices.

The Impact of Media on Teen Body Image

Research shows teen body image is shaped by factors. These include friends and family, where the teen lives, and their culture. However, celebrity images have a profound impact.

The "Ideal to Real" body image survey found 80 percent of teen girls compare themselves to images of celebrities. Moreover, almost half said that celebrity images make them feel dissatisfied.

Appearance is among teenagers' top concerns, teen girls in particular. Celebrities Influence Teen Eating Disorders

Why does celebrity influence on body image matter? Body dissatisfaction is linked to mental health challenges, including eating disorders, depression, and low self-esteem. Young women who consume media with images of an unrealistic "thin ideal" are more likely to

exhibit symptoms. Mearly half of girls ages 13 to 17 wish they were as skinny as models.

And it's not just teen girls. Research shows young men also experience body dissatisfaction and depression as a result of viewing media images. This dissatisfaction can lead to unhealthy, excessive exercising. Positive Celebrity Influence

Some celebrities influence body-image for the better. For example, singer Lorde called out a Photoshopped image of herself. "Remember, flaws are ok," she tweeted.

Other celebrities, including Rihanna, Beyoncé, Melissa McCarthy, and Jennifer Lawrence have spoken out against the ideals of beauty. Substance Use and Celebrity Influences Celebrities influence teens in other ways. When stars post images of drinking or smoking on social media, they normalize substance use. Furthermore, they make it appear attractive and cool.
