



ON SCREEN BLACK ADAM

ot long into "Black Adam," a preteen boy looks up at the hulk of Dwayne Johnson and begs for his help: "We could use a superhero right now." Speak for yourself, kid.

Do we need another superhero with another origin story that stretches back thousands of years? Do we really need another clutch of secondary level heroes?

"Black Adam" isn't bad, it's just predictable and color-by-numbers, stealing from other films. But Johnson is a natural in the title role, mixing might with humor and able to deliver those necessary wooden lines.

Like Marvel's "Eternals," "Black Adam' gets out of the blocks sluggishly with the tangled tale of our setting - Kahndaq, a fictional Middle Eastern kingdom in 2,600 B.C. that has wizards, a blood-thirsty king, a magical crown and Eternium, a rare metallic ore with energy-manipulating properties.

Flash-forward to present day, where Kahndaq is under the rule of the organized



crime syndicate Intergang and its citizens are ripe to rebel. They think they have a leader in Black Adam (Teth Adam, when he is introduced), who is released from his 5,000-year-long tomb and is naturally cranky. Is he a force for good or bad? The answer is yes.

Quintessa Swindell as Cyclone, who can control the wind. They apparently left home the superhero with the ability to open jars.

Yet the other superheroes in the DC pantheon

aren't sure about the new guy and send the Plan B

of muscle from leftover members of a knock-off

organization called the Justice Society of America.

There's Doctor Fate (a dollar-store

Doctor Strange played by Pierce Brosnan),

Black Adam is more than a match for all of them combined. He can fly, move as fast as The Flash, catch rockets, deflect bullets and

Roberts and Clooney play Georgia and

harness his own electricity. Mostly he does this weirdly passive thing of just floating.

Director Jaume Collet-Serra and the design team do a great job in every department but are let down by a derivative and baggy screenplay that goes from one violent scene to another like a video game. At one point, with the audience exhausted by the carnage, they introduce skeletons who rise up as a legion from hell.

They nicely include pockets of humor that DC has not always done well — a recurring bit with "Baby Come Back" and teaching Black Adam satire are fun; a Clint Eastwood gag fails.

Amidst the punching superheroes are two humans - a rebel leader and her skateboard-and-comics-loving pre-teen son. played by Sarah Shahi and Bodhi Sabongui. Comedian Mohammed Amer is a bolt of humor.

Most intriguing is the notion of hero itself. The Justice Society members are shocked to find that they aren't seen as heroic. Black Adam has come to help, even if he's a little violent.

"There are only heroes and villains. Heroes don't kill people," a confused Hawkman states. Black Adam replies: "Well, I do."

The number of — ahem — call-backs to other films is pretty sad - "Tomb Raider," "Back to the Future" and plenty of "Star Wars" (even, unforgivably, the line "You're our only hope".)

What the filmmakers probably had in mind was cash — selling those lunchboxes.

TICKET TO PARADISE

t's often said that the movies that were fun to make never turn out great. Well, George Clooney and Julia Roberts look like they had a grand time making the Bali-set "Ticket to Paradise."

The film, directed and co-written by Ol Parker, isn't the first movie to star Roberts and Clooney together. But their screen time together has been mostly limited to scenes in the "Ocean's Eleven" movies and Jodie Foster's thriller "Money Monster."

Given their friendship and rapport, you imagine that there must have been half-a-dozen rom-coms in their past. Instead, it's a reminder that Clooney has, when dipping into comedy, mostly stuck to an archer, Coen-brothers register. Clooney has less frequently found a perfect match. Vera Farmiga in "Up in the Air" and Meryl Streep in "Fantastic Mr. Fox" deserve mentioning. But, really, Clooney's best chemistry was back in 1998's "Out of Sight" with Jennifer Lopez. David Cotton, a bitterly divorced set of parents whose daughter, Lily (Kaitlyn Dever), is fresh out of law school. Just before she

They bicker, so much so that it's clear that their feelings are still strong for one another. I know this comes as a shock. But, yes, the events of "Ticket to Paradise" will bring them closer again.

OK, so Parker's film is not exactly out here to reinvent the wheel. Predictability is part of the appeal.

There are other traditions that fill "Ticket to Paradise" as the Cottons wrestle with and succumb to Balinese culture. But none so much as the customs of the rom-com. "Ticket to Paradise" could have greatly benefitted from a funny person taking a pass on the script. There's not nearly as much to laugh at here as you might expect.

"Ticket to Paradise" goes down as a footnote to the many superior rom-coms Roberts has sparkled in. And if I wanted to watch Clooney in a tropical locale, I'd choose Alexander Payne's "The Descendants."

But if you just want to see Roberts and Clooney together, "Ticket to Paradise" clears that not-very-high bar with just enough charm.

WINE AND CHEESE 101

IMPRESS YOUR FRIENDS THIS HOLIDAY SEASON

When you have a wine tasting party only invite the amount of people that you can fit comfortably. Always be sure to have bottled water on hand. This allows your guests to rinse their mouths between different wines. It is also important to provide food that will not change the way the wine tastes. Snacks include bread or unsalted crackers.

Decanting

Decanting is the process of letting wine breathe before you serve it. However, decanting is also when you pour your wine into a different container to allow the breathing. Some people even apply a special filter when decanting.

Younger bottles benefit more to an aeration process than older bottles. However, sediment is more common with older bottles. Airing out the bottle can relax the flavor, making the taste smoother. However, not all wines benefit. Some wines are meant to drink immediately after popping the cork. The best way to tell is to taste it first.

Blind Tasting

The best way to hold a wine tasting is by blindly serving the wine. This means you do not want the guests to know what you are serving. You might want to serve in a black wine glass. Guests should also not see the shape of the bottle or the label.

You never want a wine taster's judgment to be altered because they know details of a wine. Certain considerations that can alter a taster's judgment include price, reputation, color, and the geographic region.

People have expectations when they know these considerations. If a wine is very expensive or comes from a certain region some people tend to have expectations of the different varietals. Eliminating expectations allows a wine tasting to go smoother.

Vertical Tasting

When you have a vertical wine tasting you will have one varietal of wine from the same vintage. This means you might have the same wine from different years. The most common

purpose of tasting wines like this is to get a good idea of a certain wineries style and composition. You can also get an understanding how different weather patterns affect grapes.

Horizontal Tasting

When a horizontal tasting occurs you use the same wine from many different producers. This type of tasting allows you to determine which wineries you think produce the better wine. This wine will be from the same year and the same type of wine but from different wineries.

Tasting Flights

When you hold a tasting flight you will have many glasses of wine out. Next to each glass you will have a card including the specifics of the wine. Some flights include up to 50 glasses of wine.

This gives a taster an idea what types of wines come from certain parts of the world. You can also get a good idea of the different tastes of the different types of wines.

Old World Vs New World Tasting

Many people enjoy this wine tasting. Old World is considered to be countries like France, Italy, Austria, Spain, etc. New World is North America, South America, South Africa, New Zealand, and Australia.

The reason these countries are considered to be the New World is because they are new to the wine producing industry and late starters. However, these countries are significant in producing wines.

Many people like to feature the same types of wines from old and new worlds.

Wine and Cheese Tasting

There are many different palate influences that cheese has when you drink wine.
When you taste specific wine combinations properly you will understand how well cheese and wine go together.

The best way to serve a Cabernet sauvignon is with blue cheese. You might serve the blue cheese with an unflavored



French bread also. The blue cheese acts by coating the mouth and laying a foundation which will soften the wine. Test this by taking a taste of the wine first. Wait a minute. Then take a bite of the cheese and take another drink. You will see a difference.

Wine and Chocolate Tasting

Chocolate and wine go together if you do it right. WIt is important to be sure the wine is as sweet as the chocolate. If you have a wine that is not as sweet it will cause the wine to taste sour. If you want to serve lighter wines it is best to stick with chocolates that are lighter also.

Priceless Tasting

Priceless wine tasting is not telling the guests how much the wine costs. When guests know the price their judgment is tainted.

Price point Tasting

Price point tasting method is very similar to priceless tasting. However, you will use wines that are in the same price range when you serve the wines.

Big 8 Tasting


A Big 8 tasting includes the different varietals of the Big 8 wines in a tasting flight. Red wines included are Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Shiraz, and Merlot. White wines are Chardonnay, Riesling, Pinot, and the Sauvignon Blanc. This is great when your guests don't know the differences with varietals. CAT TRAINING

How to Stop Your Cat From Scratching Your Furniture

f you have a cat then you will probably come up against a problem that has been faced by many a cat owner before you and that is: your cat is scratching your furniture and in the process, making a really good job of defacing it and destroying it.

If you are having this problem then I imagine your nerves are shredded just like your sofa! And it seems no matter what you do to your cat or how much you tell off your cat that it doesn't make any difference. And why should it as don't forget this is a cat you are dealing with.

Remember first though that scratching is an entirely natural behaviour for cats and is done for four main reasons:

Territory marking: this is a way for your cat to use scratching as a way of marking their province by visible marking i.e. the scratches, but also through scent which is deposited through scent glands on the cats paws

To keep their nails clean and healthy

Exercise: Scratching allows your cat to stretch, pull and work its front quarter muscles

Pleasure: It's an emotional release and your cat just likes to do it!

So if you think you can get your cat to stop scratching then think again and get used to it.

To handle the issue of your cat scratching your furniture, your strategy will have to exclude the option of stopping your cat scratching and instead focus on training your cat to scratch elsewhere. We can do this by a mixture of making the furniture undesirable to scratch and providing more desirable places to scratch.

Before I go any further though I need to say this one thing. Don't ever punish your cat for scratching your furniture. The reason is that your cat is doing what comes naturally and won't understand why you are punishing it. It will only know that sometimes, for some reason, you will treat it badly and this can lead to insecurity in the cat which may lead the cat to scratch more or develop other unwanted behaviors.

Let's look at providing more desirable places to scratch.

The best option is scratching posts. These need to at least 28 inches tall for your cat to fully stretch its body and be very stable with a large base. If the post is not stable then the risk is that it will topple over when the cat first tries to use it and if that happens then the cat will not use it again. The post needs to be covered in a rough material that the cat can shred to bits. A post covered with sisal textile material is a good example. The post themselves are best placed where the cat spends most of its time, not hidden away in a corner somewhere. It would also be a good idea to have an additional post near where the cat sleeps as cats like to scratch when they awaken.

When you first put the post in position then follow it up by playing with your

cat near the post. You may find that rubbing the post with material with catnip will entice your cat but this may not work for every cat. Try scratching your

own nails along the post surface to attract your cat and teach it where to scratch. When the cat does start scratching then praise it and give it a food treat. If your cat has been scratching an area of carpet then try covering the area with another, smaller piece of carpet but turn it over to show the reverse side so that a satisfactory resistant texture is provided for scratching. The smaller carpet must be stationary so secure it in place with duct tape.



If your cat is reluctant to give up the old scratching areas then you can take steps to make these places less desirable to scratch.

Try covering the furniture with double sided tape or aluminium foil. These materials don't provide a texture that feels good to scratch so are good for discouraging scratching. As I mentioned earlier, scratching is a way for your cat to mark its territory with scent so you will need to remove the cats scent from the affected furniture. Try pet odor removers available from pet shops and supermarkets. Cats have an aversion to citrus odors so try lemon scented spray to make the furniture less desirable.

If the scratching persists then try squirting the cat with a small water spray/pistol or using a loud whistle. With these options you need to be present when the scratching occurs to establish an aversion to the area you don't want the cat to scratch.

I wish you the best of luck with your cat relationships and training and hope you manage to speedily resolve the scratching issue.

A second grader in Jacksonville, Florida, has been expelled from Victory Christian Academy after their parents objected to a homework assignment suggesting students "send a picture of you doing reading homework in the bathtub," Action News Jax reported on Sept. 22. Misty Dunham emailed the teacher: "Hey, you might want to explain that. Send something out to the parents. Let them know what the intentions are." Dunham also reached out to school administrators and the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office. School officials responded by suggesting that the Dunhams "should do a parental withdrawal for the child." When Dunham refused, the school expelled the 8-year-old. Pastor Jesse Latta issued a statement about the assignment but did not address the child's removal from the school.

American Airlines appears to have an unexplained noise issue on its planes, The Washington Post reported. On a Sept. 6 flight from Los Angeles to Dallas, passengers were subjected to groans and moaning that sounded human and vaguely sexual. Passenger and film producer Emerson Collins recorded the noises and posted them to TikTok; his guess was that someone was pranking the public address system on the plane. Collins walked up and down the aisle looking for a possible culprit, but "I didn't see anything," he said. Passengers on different American flights have reported hearing a hearty "oh yeah" when the plane landed and the "moans and groans of someone in extreme pain," but spokesperson Sarah Jantz said the noises are "caused by a mechanical issue with the PA amplifier." Maybe. Or maybe the ghosts of passengers past?

In January, Reebok introduced a new sneaker in collaboration with the French luxury brand Maison Margiella. The Classic Leather Decortique Tabi Low is distinctive for its "toe cleavage" design -- and now, Indy100 reported, for being identified as a sign of the devil. A Facebook page called Prophecy News warned followers on Sept. 19 that the shoes resemble the feet of Baphomet, a goat deity associated with the occult. Reebok's Instagram account has drawn similar reactions: "This is so satanic!! My family will never buy another shoe from you," one follower wrote. Another said, "Satanic, no way will I ever wear those." Reebok counters that the shoes are

based on a traditional Japanese shoe design called tabi.

Food Fuss

The Kitchen at London House, a popular restaurant on the Isle of Wight in the United Kingdom, put their foot down in August when they rolled out their new menu with no vegan items, the Daily Mail reported. The eatery used to feature some vegan selections, but owner Sally Cooper said they stopped because of a "militant minority. ... (W)e got fed up with the arrogant, 'holier-than-thou' attitude. ... If you want vegan food, go to a vegan restaurant.

Armed and Clumsy

On Oct. 6, Burlington (North Carolina) police officers responded to a call around 7 a.m., the News & Record reported. A homeowner told them that as he walked from his car to his front door, an armed man approached him and tried to force his way inside the house. The two struggled, and a gunshot grazed the victim's chest, but he wasn't seriously injured. The victim was able to slam the door on the suspect -or, more precisely, on the suspect's hand. As investigators processed the scene, they found a glove with a severed finger inside, which they used to identify Vernon Forest Wilson, 67. He was booked on multiple charges in Alamance County and held on \$250,000 bond.



TEACH KIDS EARTH FRIENDLY **HABITS**

r or many parents, their interest in sustainability and earth-friendly living is driven by a desire to create a better world for their children. Taking personal action and responsibility are part of the solution but teaching the next generation to be environmentally conscious is an important part of the equation, too.

Connecting lessons about sustainability to familiar aspects of your child's daily life, like school, can makes it easy for him or her to understand and establish earth-friendly habits from a young age. Here are some ideas for promoting sustainable behaviors this school year:

Be smart about supplies. Before restocking your student's supplies, take inventory of what you have left over from last year. Your student probably had several items with plenty of life left, or things that were bought as backups, so you can avoid waste and save a little money while reducing your consumption of unnecessary goods.

Model good habits. Kids learn by example, so know they're watching and internalizing your behaviors. If you're not already practicing these habits, make an intentional effort to turn lights off before you leave the house each morning, turn off the water while brushing teeth, use alternate energy sources around the house and encourage your school district to adopt sustainable practices, such as propane-powered buses.

Reduce food-based waste. Convenient, single-serve packaging makes assembling school lunches a breeze, but all that extra wrapping is waste that ends up in the landfill. Other options, like buying in bulk and sending treats in reusable plastic bags, is a more earth-friendly approach. Bento-style boxes with compartments for different foods are another option to help make lunchtime more sustainable. Similarly, encourage your child to carry a water bottle at school each day, which reduces water fountain waste (and cuts back on his or her exposure to germs).

Enjoy nature together. As temperatures cool, it's a terrific opportunity to spend

quality time outdoors as a family. Showing your child reasons to appreciate nature can make it easier for him or her to understand and provide motivation to make choices that protect the earth.

Reinforce with reading. Multiple studies reinforce the benefits of reading Georgia State University, students who ride to school on a low-emissions bus, like propane, had higher test scores than those who rode on diesel buses.

Today, there are two main options for clean student transportation: propane and electric. While both reduce emissions. propane can do it at a fraction of the cost.

Every day, 1.3 million American children ride to school in 22,000 propane-powered school buses. Propane buses are currently in 1,000 school districts in 48 states. That's only about 5% of the nation's total buses, but the number is growing. These are the reasons more districts are moving to propane powered transportation: Student Health and the Environment

The cloud of black smoke that comes from the tailpipe of a diesel bus contains harmful emissions that are classified as a carcinogen and are known triggers for issues like asthma, bronchitis and other respiratory problems, according to the Environmental Protection Agency. Propane school buses lower those emissions to near-zero levels, which improves air quality and eliminates concerns about breathing-related issues. In fact, according to a study by

Compared to electric, propane buses provide a lower lifetime carbon option. That includes emissions that take place before the wheels start turning on the road, like charging a bus using the electric grid versus refueling it with propane. Coal and natural gas are still America's primary sources of energy for electricity generation and drive up emissions. Cost Savings

Three times less expensive than electric buses, the cost of a propane school bus and its refueling infrastructure is one of the most affordable options for school districts.

School districts can save money throughout the lifetime of propane buses, which cost 30-50% less per mile to operate than diesel, according to the Propane Education & Research Council. What's more, a World LP Gas Association study found replacing diesel buses with propane buses would save enough money to hire 23,000 new teachers. Reliability

While electric vehicles make sense for several uses, propane has the fuel range and performance needed for large vehicles that drive long distances without stopping to recharge or refuel. A typical propane school bus can drive more than 2.5 times farther on a full tank than a comparable electric school bus can drive on a full charge.


