Welcome to the Renaissance and the outrageous, crowd-pleasing musical farce, Something Rotten playing through May 29, 2022 at the Simi Valley Cultural Arts Center, 3050 East Los Angeles Avenue, Simi Valley CA 93065. Created by Grammy Award-winning songwriter Wayne Kirkpatrick, and successful screenwriters Karey Kirkpatrick and John O'Farrell, Something Rotten was lauded by audience members and critics alike, receiving several Best Musical nominations and hailed by Time Out New York as "the funniest musical comedy in at least 400 years".

Set in the 1590s, brothers Nick and Nigel Bottom are desperate to write a hit play but are stuck in the shadow of that Renaissance rock star known as "The Bard." Something Rotten features large song and dance numbers, and a wacky cast of





NATURALLY TAN

BODY IMAGE, MINORITY STATUS, AND SELF-ESTEEM PLAYING THROUGH MAY 28 AT THE BLACK BOX THEATER

ody image, minority status, and self-esteem are just a few of the topics discussed in Naturally Tan, a one-woman show about her cross-cultural path to self-worth that is written and performed by Tanya Thomas.

Tanya voices and acts over 35 characters, most notably a vivacious drag queen named Tanvi who leads the audience through the performance. The show follows Tanya's desperation to fit in as a minority growing up in Singapore where the ideals of beauty amounted to fair skin and the Pan Asian

look. Colorism and damaging beauty standards are all too real in the Asian country – which made Tanya's decidedly darker-skinned looks unpopular in her headspace.

Insecurities plague Tonya as she grows up in Singapore – all part of the impossible goals for young women in the country. The show asks will she hide behind them forever or will she overcome them as a woman of color, mother, and artist? Even purportedly Asian-themed movies like Crazy, Rich Asians are a disappointment, states Tanya, as they do not follow through



on the different peoples and looks of the

Through music, seriocomic elements, music, dance, and compelling visuals, Tanya takes on a journey where she finds and believes in herself, something we all can learn from.

Tanya Thomas is the playwright of Naturally Tan and performs all of the characters during its 90-minute running time. She is also an award-winning solo artist, producer, actress, and voiceover artist who started her career hosting Top 40 radio shows in Singapore, and jazz shows on KJAZZ 88.1 in Long Beach (which is mentioned in the show) and hosting three podcasts for Apple.

Naturally Tan debuted as an official selection of Solofest 2021 at Whitefire Theatre in Los Angeles where it also won a Best of Fest Award. Doctor Strange 2

nce a superhero franchise goes multiverse, it's hard to go back. No work of fiction ever needs permission to break the rules or push the boundaries, but the multiverse, at least as it's been served up in recent Marvel movies demands it. And for the moment that means a lot of cameo opportunities. "Spider-Man: No Way Home" opened the door to the concept, but now Benedict Cumberbatch's master of the mystic arts is flying through the interdimensional portal with the concept in "Doctor Strange in the Multiverse of Madness."

This film is technically the sequel to "Doctor Strange." But so much has happened in Marvel land that involves Stephen Strange and his goatee—
"Infinity War," "Endgame" and, yes, the most recent "Spider-Man"—that where it falls in the "Doctor Strange" standalone film continuity is entirely beside the point. One could not watch "Doctor Strange" and then "Doctor Strange 2" and expect it to make sense.

Not only that, being invested in "Doctor Strange 2," also requires some knowledge of "Wanda Vision," the nine-episode Disney+ series that runs almost six hours total. This is not a surprise

or a burden to Marvel fans, but it does seem like quite a lot to ask of the average moviegoer.

So it's interesting that Sam Raimi agreed to jump into this messy multiverse. His "Spider-Man" movies are still among the top of the crop of modern superhero franchises, after all. Raimi was able to put his own stamp on this endeavor, including a Bruce Campbell cameo. There are horror elements, too, some so intense families might think twice before bringing everyone, some interesting visuals not entirely dissimilar to "Inception" and some humor. But Raimi doesn't take "Doctor Strange" to an entirely new place. He mostly sticks to the framework established by Scott Derrickson.

The main issue is that it's a bit of a kitchen sink movie centered on a new and underdeveloped character, America Chavez (Xochitl Gomez), a teen who has the power to travel the multiverse but doesn't know how to control it. She's being hunted by someone who wants her powers and Strange decides to help.

Unfortunately, he asks the wrong Avenger for help: Elizbeth Olsen's Wanda Maximoff is the one



after the power to go multiverse jumping and has been dabbling in some dark arts to make it happen. She's motivated by the idea that she has children out there in an idyllic suburban multiverse in which she wears yoga pants and loose cotton tops and tucks her boys in at night after ice cream and movies. Soon she and Strange are having a standoff in midair.

The script is inventive in the way it plays around with a jumble of big sci-fi concepts, which makes sense considering screenwriter Michael Waldron is a veteran of "Rick & Morty." But it also underwhelms when it comes to the mishmash structure and the women. Olsen still sells Wanda's pain like the best of them, even though she's been reduced to a stereotype of female hysteria. Christine is merely there to make Strange

realize things about himself. And America, well, she never really earns our emotional investment.

After "Infinity War" and "Endgame," "Doctor Strange in the Multiverse of Madness" feels a little bit like wheel spinning. Cumberbatch has fun with his character, but his limitless ego seems to have been a little muted here as he grapples with his own happiness. And that invites more questions, like do we ultimately care about whether or not Doctor Strange is happy? Does he? Could everyone just use some post blip therapy instead of these interdimensional bottle episodes?

Perhaps the Marvel universe is finally starting to feel like a long running comic book series. Or maybe Phase 4 just hasn't kicked into gear just yet.

Happening," Audrey Diwan's Golden Lion-winner at last year's Venice Film Festival, is set in 1963 France but the period detail isn't prominent. It's an abortion tale that feels as though it could it could take place in many places, long ago or today.

It's filmed in square-like academy ratio and it's as if the edges of the frame are closing in on Anne Duchesne (Anamaria Vartolomei), a smart literature student — maybe even brilliant; we see her define "anaphora" without hesitation — who is shocked when a doctor informs her that she's pregnant.

This is 12 years before abortion would be legalized in France and Anne's predicament is urgent. "Do something," she tells the doctor, who replies that it's impossible, "the law is unsparing." For Anne, her first sexual encounter threatens to derail her life just as it's getting started. She comes from a working class background. Her parents — and Anne, herself — have high expectations.

"I want to continue my studies," she tells another doctor. "It's essential for me."

Films from Cristian Mungiu's "4 Months, 3 Weeks and 2 Days" to Eliza Hittman's "Never Sometimes Always Rarely" have captured the human toll of systems that give women little choice when faced with an unwanted pregnancy. What distinguishes "Happening," is, overwhelmingly, her and Laurent Tangy's tightly composed cinematography and Vartolomei's riveting, steely performance. To a remarkable degree, "Happening" is viscerally connected with its protagonist, closely detailing not just her navigation of social taboos and restrictions but capturing her unapologetic determination. It's a movie about abortion, yes, but it's also a coming-of-age tale.

"Happening" is based on the 2001 memoir by French author Annie Ernaux, who framed her '60s experience as it was recalled decades later by sifting through old journals and memories. Diwan's



film has no such framework, instead preferring to stay rigorously close to Anne's experience as it's unfolding. Abortion is to even her friends an unspeakable subject; just the hint of promiscuity is enough to make her an outcast. In one vulnerable scene, classmates confront her in the shower for being "loose" while they and she are naked.

In "Happening," there's no pleasure for Anne's body. It's a battleground. She is in a kind of war, with no one on her side, desperate for help — or at least for honesty. Anne grows increasingly isolated but also defiant. In a film where no one wants to say the truth out loud, "Happening" culminates in Anne holding back screams of pain because the walls are too thin.





Great Types of Exercises for Swimmers

A lot of swimmers supplement their program with exercises in the gym. We have put together a list of some of the best exercises for swimmers to do outside of the water. Medicine Ball Exercises For Swimmers

Medicine-ball training for swimmers is categorised as functional training. This means it uses multiple muscles to complete a movement.

This type of movement can be much more beneficial because it trains your bodies parts to work together more effectively rather than just improving one element. Stretchcord Exercises For Swimmers

Stretchcords are giant rubber bands with varying degrees of thickness according to ability and training requirements.

The idea of stretchcord training exercises is to pull on the band as you would pull through water in your swimming strokes, with the resistance providing a work-out that closely simulates the resistance you feel in the water.

Stretchcords are also particularly useful for injuries. They are often used by physios to help nurse muscle groups together. Weight Training Exercises For Swimmers

Proper lifting is a must if you are doing any sort of weight training. Seek a professional to teach you proper techniques before you try any weight lifting. You won't get



the benefit out of the program unless the technique is correct.

Maximum muscular strength gains can be obtained from a heavy-resistance-low-repetition training programme, while muscular endurance is more effectively achieved through light-resistance-high-repetition programmes.

Lie on the bench holding two dumb-bells, face up. Lower each

weight until level with the chest and then return. On the up phase, rotate the shoulders externally. At the bottom point the thumbs inwards. At the top, thumbs point behind the head. At the low point the elbows should be at 90 degrees, in line with the shoulders.

Exercises For Swimmers At Home

Most competitive swimmers will do some sort of land training at home as well as the programme at their local swimming club set by the coach.

Even if it is stretching this can be a really great habit to get into when your are trying to be more flexible.

Flexibility can produce lots of power in swimming.

500 sit ups a day is a great routine to get into. Make it a habit when you get out of bed in the morning.

The sit-up should be like a roll-up. You should roll all the way up until your chest touches your knees. On the way down you unroll. Swiss Ball Swimming Exercises

Swiss balls help improve your core. Swiss balls are an excellent way to build up core-strength.

Training with a Swiss ball forces you to use muscles that stabilise and control the body's position. You add complexity by shifting to more unstable positions over time.

Swiss ball exercises are used to: Increase the core-strength of the muscles in the trunk of the body; Improve your posture; Improve joint stability and control – reduces the chance of injury; Improves flexibility and range of motion in your joints.

It's important to choose the right Swiss ball for you as they come in a variety of shapes and sizes.

Circuit Training For Swimmers

Circuit training is usually aimed at individuals rather than groups because each circuit or WOD can be tailored to the specific person. CrossFit or Circuit Training is designed to improve all-round physical fitness rather than fitness for a specific sport.

Swimming specific CrossFit training or Circuit Training means you should be working at sub-maximum level over an extended period of time with either no rest, or very little rest between exercises. Stretching Exercises For Swimmers

Stretching is very important for swimmers. What you should be thinking about when you are doing warm up exercises for swimming is making them dynamic rather than static. A dynamic warm up is stretching with movement. For example: arm swings, trunk twists and lunges. A dynamic warm up helps swimmers pre-pare before getting in the pool.

Can Cats Eat Garlic? What You Need to Know!

Cats are notorious for being persuasive. If their begging eyes and sweet purrs don't convince you, the threat of claws and dead mice in your shoes undoubtedly will.

Is Garlic Safe for Cats?
Garlic is part of the Allium
genus, along with onions,
chives, leeks, and shallots. All
those foods are considered
toxic to cats and dogs alike,
but some are worse than
others.

Garlic is one of the most dangerous of the bunch. It's five times more toxic than onions for both cats and dogs.

If your cat eats enough garlic, they run the risk of contracting garlic poisoning. This can lead to something called hemolytic anemia, which causes their body to attack their own red blood cells.

The good news is that if you act fast, you can minimize the damage and possibly even prevent hemolytic anemia from setting in at all.

What Are the Signs of Garlic Poisoning in Cats?

If your cat has eaten a toxic amount of garlic, you'll soon see some or all of the following symptoms:

Vomiting, Diarrhea, Difficulty breathing, Lethargy, Increased respiratory rate, Increased heart rate, Pale gums or Collapse.

It's important to understand that these symptoms might not set in immediately. In some cases, it can take as long as 4 days for the garlic to begin to cause noticeable issues with your cat's blood cells.

By then, however, it may be too late to undo some of the damage,

which is why you should take action as soon as you know that the garlic has been ingested, rather than waiting for symptoms to occur.

How Much Garlic Is Toxic to a Cat?

While garlic isn't good for cats, that doesn't mean that the slightest bit will kill them.



It's believed that any amount over 5 grams per kilogram can trigger toxicity in cats, but the cat's breed can play a role as well. For some reason, Asian breeds seem to be more sensitive to the effects than others, so if you have a Siamese, Burmese, or another Asian breed, you might want to err on the side of caution.

What Should You Do If You Suspect That Your Cat Is Suffering From Garlic Poisoning?

The most important thing is to act as soon as you can. Take your cat to your vet, and try to recap exactly which symptoms you've observed, as well as how much garlic was consumed.

Depending on how long it's been since the cat has ingested the garlic, the vet may want to give your cat activated charcoal to soak up the toxins or induce vomiting by forcing the cat to swallow hydrogen peroxide. If these methods are successful, the cat should have a good chance of recovery, and the damage to their body (and your bank account) should be minimal.

However, if it's been too long for either of those techniques to be effective, your vet may want to perform blood panels to see if toxicosis has set in. In many cases, rest and proper nutrition (and avoiding other members of the Allium group) should be all your cat needs to recover.

If the garlic poisoning has reached a critical stage, supplemental oxygen, IV fluids or even a blood transfusion may be needed. This is where the prognosis can

> get dicey, as cats with severe or prolonged garlic poisoning are prone to suffering from other complications besides the anemia.

How to Prevent Your Cat From Eating Garlic?

Most cats aren't attracted to cloves of garlic, so there shouldn't be any need to hide your garlic or anything like that.

As you might expect, the easiest way to prevent a garlic overdose is to control your own behavior. If you know a dish has garlic in it, don't share it with your cat, and be sure not to leave out any meats or other tantalizing, garlic-laced foods where your cat might be able to reach them.

Likewise, you should find another supplement or flea treatment besides garlic to give your cat, as it's just not worth the risk.

What's the Verdict?

Under no circumstances should you give your cat garlic. While a small amount is unlikely to be harmful, it's easy to give them too much, at which point, garlic poisoning can set in — and this can kill your precious kitty.

We know that it's not easy to tell a cat "no" when they turn on the charm, but you're going to have to find a way to do it when there's garlic involved.

house is the most expensive and valuable asset we own. House-buying feels real when you go on house viewings. A few things to keep in mind: Empty rooms feel larger than they really are. Bring a tape measure and record the dimensions.

Ask to view your top choices a second time. You'll become more attentive to practical things, like the workmanship on the interior trims, alignment of the tiles, the direction of the sunrise and sunset, sizes of the main rooms, ventilation, and so forth.

Pay Close Attention To

House viewings are fun, especially when close friends and family go with you. Use the time to inspect the properties thoroughly and take notes of the pros and cons. Pay extra attention to:

The neighborhood. You eed to get a feel of the type of people living next door. Are there families with little kids? Does it seem like the people are friendly? Find out if you feel comfortable living in the area and can mingle with the local community. You don't want to live in a place where you can't trust people.

The surroundings. There are lots of vegetation around the house: is this a pro or a con? The neighborhood is near a body of water. Is it prone to flooding?

This is a matter of weighing the pros and cons of a house. You can get this information by observing the structural designs of the houses in the area and talking to passersby when you look at the property.

The asking price and how it compares to the rest of the houses. Pay attention to is the cost, the

obvious reason being you need to know if you can afford the mortgage. Here's a quick and simple formula: add all the monthly housing costs like mortgage, insurance, taxes, and association fees. If it is less than or equal to 25% of your monthly take-home pay, you may be able to afford it.

Real estate is an investment: you'll want to find out if a property you purchase can still increase in value in the coming years.

The downpayment. Make sure you fully understand the responsibilities that come with owning a house. Bear in mind that your monthly mortgage excludes the downpayment, closing costs, and your move-in expenses. Zillow reports that the closing cost of a house sale is typically 2% to 5% of the purchase price.

The condition of the trim. Before a house is opened for viewing, it is customary for the owner to retouch the facade and finishes. The "facelift" might hide underlying defects that could lead to bigger problems. So if the trim looks brand-new, be more scrutinizing of the adjacent wood or the surrounding concrete.

The shape of the rooms. Listing photos can be misleading. Real estate photographers often use wide-angle lenses. The distorted perspective may hide the real shape of the space.




erhaps no three letters are as closely associated with luxury and class as BMW.

The automotive company has come a long way since its first car, the 1927 Dixi 3/15 PS DA-1, which maxed out at 75 miles per hour.

Now, BMWs are lightning fast and gorgeously sleek. Yet, to own some of the top models will cost you a pretty penny.

Today, we're breaking down the five most expensive BMW cars of all time.

Have a few million dollars sitting around you've been itching to spin? Let's take a look at what your money can get you:



The Most Expensive BMW: 1991 Nazca M12: \$3 Million

Yes, you read that correctly.

The idea for this concept car was originally conceived by automobile designer Giorgetto Giugiaro, who came up with the model for engineering company Italdesign.

Though it never went into production, there were three Nazca M12s made. In 2011, one went up for auction for \$1.1 million.

With its carbon fiber body and BMW's stellar V12 engine (the same in less-than-reliable demand meant it

the 750i and 850i), experts estimate its value to have more than doubled now. BMW M8: At Least \$590,000

Kept under wraps for about 15 years, the BMW M8 became somewhat of a fable in the automotive industry.

The prototype, created in the early 1990s, was a fire-engine red stunner boasting 500+ horsepower and six-speed rear-wheel drive. At the time, it was the most tech-savvy car BMW had ever designed.

Yet, a fluctuating market and

was destined to be kept under wraps, where it remained until 2010 when it was displayed in Munich.

While it's valued at just under \$600,000, the mystery swirling around the model lends itself to even higher estimates.

BMW X5 Le Mans Concept: \$590,000

The oldest active sports car race in the world, Le Mans is the benchmark against which automobile manufacturers judge the speed, quality, and craftsmanship of their products.

In 1999, BMW won Le Mans with a high-power V12 engine.

The manufacturer then took that engine and ran with it: it incorporated it into its X5 series, an unlikely match considering the X5 is a luxury mid-sized SUV better suited for a family than the racetrack.

The resulting vehicle? An uber-strong and crazy fast BMW that could go from 0 to 60 miles per hour in less than five seconds.

Try taking that through the carpool lane or a BMW service center without turning some heads! BMW M5 G-Power Hurricane RRs: \$470,000

Looking for a sedan powered by an 830 horsepower V10 engine that can reach speeds of up to 231 miles per hour? The M5 G-Power Hurricane RRs delivers.

One of the fastest and most expensive BMW sedans ever, it's created in partnership with G-Power, the Bavaria-based car tuning manufacturer behind high-powered luxury vehicles. BMW M5 G-Power Hurricane CS: Mid \$400,000s

With a slightly lower output (and a lower price tag) the CS model boasts many of the same features as the RRs.

The V10 engine on this model is 750 horsepower. It also features a nine-way adjustable suspension, as well as carbon fiber seats, giving you all the power and agility you'd expect from one of the most expensive BMW models.

LIFEGUARDS RETURN TO VENTURA HARBOR



As the summer season approaches, daily lifeguard service will be provided at Ventura Harbor beaches along Spinnaker Drive.

For over 60 years, State Parks has provided professional lifeguarding services along California's coastline. The Ventura Port District took the lead in securing summer lifeguards at the Harbor in 2011. The state lifeguards and the Ventura Harbor Patrol have formed a strong and effective partnership in providing public safety on land and in the waters along Ventura's coast.

"The designated safe family-friendly beach is Harbor Cove which is within the Harbor and sheltered from the offshore waves. South of Harbor Cove is approximately 1 mile of coastal beach, that while protected by lifeguards, is for the more experienced swimmers and surfers due to rip-currents," stated Ventura Port District Harbormaster John Higgins.

In cooperation, the Harbor Patrol and the State Parks Lifeguards have over the years, performed many rescues and prevented numerous serious incidents. The beach had historically high visitors and challenging conditions, but because of the Ventura Port District's investment, most rescues were routine in nature. In fact, the Lifeguard service continues to provide better preventative care through education and has reduced the number of circumstances where first responders are also at risk. The Harbor Patrol and State



Lifeguards have grown a strong and effective partnership in providing public safety on land and water areas throughout the Ventura coastline. Both agencies participate in cross training and assist each other throughout the year on routine and emergency calls.

Ventura Harbor and its beaches have become among the most popular summer destinations in the city. Parking and restrooms are available at both beach parking lots, EV charging stations at Harbor Cove Beach sponsored by Sema-Connect, and street parking is available on Spinnaker Drive. Beach wheelchairs are equipped with large, wide wheels which can roll across the sand without sinking and are available on a first-come, first-served basis by calling ahead for availability at 805.642.8618

n addition to the beaches' safety and convenience, annual Harbor dredging results in some of the best sand on the local coast. Also, the location affords a variety of healthy outdoor summer activities and close access to the Harbor Village and its many amenities.

"Ventura Harbor is one of the few locations in Ventura County that provides a complete user experience," added Higgins. "Our harbor, beaches, merchants, restaurants, national park headquarters, sport fishing boats, dive boats and Island Packers give the visitor tremendous value and entertainment in one intimate location."




you want to channel your inner Donna and the Diamonds by wearing a pair of ruffled trousers.


