Indigenous Quilts Honoring Southern California Tribes Through Art And Tradition

uilting, an art form rooted in storytelling and community, has long been a means of expression for Indigenous peoples. While many associate quilting with European-American traditions, Native American quiltmaking has evolved into a unique and powerful medium that blends cultural heritage with contemporary artistry. Indigenous quilts serve as a tribute to the rich histories, resilience, and artistic legacies of the region's tribes,

including the Chumash, Tongva, Cahuilla, Luiseño, and Kumeyaay.

The History of Indigenous Quilting

Quilting was introduced to Native American communities through interactions with Spanish missionaries and Euro-American settlers. While pre-colonial Native textile traditions centered around weaving and basketry, the introduction of fabric and sewing techniques led to the incorporation of quilting into Indigenous artistic practices. Tribes adopted and adapted quilting into a deeply personal and symbolic craft, often incorporating

traditional designs, tribal symbols, and natural motifs. Symbolism

Quilts created by or in honor of Southern California tribes often carry deep cultural significance.

Honoring Ancestors: Some quilts are dedicated to ancestors or tribal leaders, incorporating family names, beadwork, and even traditional dyes.

Contemporary Quilters and Their Contributions

Many Indigenous quilters are creating breathtaking works that honor local tribes.

Some prominent figures include:

Cheryl L. Kline, a Tongva artist, has collaborated on quilting projects that incorporate traditional Tongva symbolism into modern quilt designs.

Cahuilla Quilters Collective, a group of artisans who create pieces reflecting their tribe's basket patterns and ancestral stories.

The Autry Museum of the American West and Malki Museum, which have showcased Indigenous quilts, bringing greater visibility to this art form.

> Community Quilting Projects, such as workshops in tribal cultural centers.

Quilting As Cultural Revitalization

Quilting has played a crucial role in cultural revitalization efforts among Southern California tribes. Many young Indigenous artists are taking up quilting as a way to reclaim and celebrate

their heritage. Elders pass down knowledge of tribal history, traditional dyeing, and the meanings behind patterns and symbols.

Additionally, exhibitions and festivals have brought increased attention to Indigenous quilting, allowing wider audiences to appreciate its significance. Events such as the California Indian Market & Peace Pow Wow and the Los Angeles Indigenous Peoples Day celebrations frequently highlight Indigenous textiles and crafts

THE CULTURAL DIVIDE, COMMON THEMES, THE GENDER BATTLE, HOT MUSIC INCLUSION, OBIT'S, TOP DOCUMENTARIES, HISTORICAL MOVIES & THE HOST: CONAN O'BRIEN

he Academy Awards are often seen as the pinnacle of recognition in the film industry. Every year, the event gamers global attention as Hollywood celebrates its finest achievements. The 2025 Academy Awards will take place against the backdrop of a rapidly changing world. The Gender Battle: Inclusivity or Tokenism?

or documentary features about legendary artists, are also likely to make waves at the 2025 Oscars. Movies like Rocket-





America's "First Car-Free Neighborhood" A Vision For Sustainable Urban Living

n the evolving landscape of urban development, where space, sustainability, and quality of life for residents are paramount, a growing number of cities across the world are exploring alternatives to car-centric living. One example of this trend is the creation of America's "first car-free neighborhood." As the name suggests, this groundbreaking urban area does not rely

on cars as the primary mode of transportation, thus offering an entirely new way of thinking about urban planning and transportation.



The Birth of the Idea

The notion of a car-free neighborhood may sound radical, given that cars have long been a part of American daily life. However, the idea gained traction, especially in response to concerns about environmental sustainability, air pollution, traffic congestion, and health implications of sedentary lifestyles. In 2019, a project was launched in Boston, Massachusetts. This initiative, known as "The Seaport District's Car-Free Concept", is touted as America's first car-free neighborhood.

has been linked to lower pollution, increased pedestrian traffic, and a sense of community. **Design and Features of the Car-Free Neighborhood**

The core idea is to prioritize pedestrians and cyclists over automobiles, which creates a radically different design. Streets are narrower, with more green spaces, parks, and public squares where people can interact and engage in leisure activities. High-density mixed-use buildings dominate, housing apartments, offices, and retail spaces. This allows residents to access essential services, such as grocery stores, restaurants, and schools, within walking or cycling distance.

Instead of traditional parking garages and wide roads, this car-free neighborhood incorporates pedestrian walkways, bike lanes, and shared spaces where people can safely walk, cycle, or socialize. The design emphasizes connectivity, accessibility, and sustainability. The neighborhood also features smart city technologies, including sensors for waste management, energy-efficient buildings, and state-of-the-art public transportation.

Another key feature is public transportation options, including electric buses, trams, and shared electric bikes or scooters. These alternatives are integrated into the infrastructure, making it convenient for residents to rely on sustainable transportation options instead of personal vehicles. The design also features seamless access to mass transit systems.

Benefits and Challenges

The implementation of a car-free neighborhood offers benefits that have been well-documented. A reduction in cars leads to a decrease in air pollution, which has health benefits.

Studies have shown that lower levels of pollution contribute to a decrease in respiratory illnesses, heart disease, and other chronic health conditions. In this sense, the Seaport District and other similar developments are positioned as a solution.

In addition to environmental and health benefits, the car-free neighborhood fosters a sense of community. With cars removed, residents are more likely to engage in face-to-face interactions, creating a safer and more vibrant atmosphere. Public spaces become more accessible to children and the elderly. Moreover, reduced reliance on cars can lead to a more equitable neighborhood.

However, the transition to a car-free lifestyle presents challenges. One of the most notable barriers is the resistance from individuals who are accustomed to car-centric living. Many Americans view cars as essential for personal freedom and convenience. Convincing people to relinquish their cars and embrace alternative transportation requires a major cultural shift and extensive education. Additionally, infrastructure improvements in other parts of the city—such as public transportation systems—are often necessary to make car-free neighborhoods a viable option.

The financial aspect of developing such a neighborhood also poses challenges. The initial cost can be high. However, proponents argue that in the long run, these investments will pay off in terms of reduced healthcare costs, environmental benefits, and improved quality of life. The Future of Car-Free Neighborhoods in the U.S.

While Boston's car-free neighborhood is still a new concept, it represents the beginning of a larger shift in how American cities approach urban development. As climate change and sustainability become more pressing issues, other cities across the United States are beginning to explore similar concepts. New York City, Portland, and Los Angeles have already taken steps toward reducing car dependence, such as expanding bike lanes and improving public transportation networks. These smaller initiatives could ultimately lead to the development of more car-free zones in urban centers across the nation.

America's first car-free neighborhood signals a future where urban living is less about car ownership and more about walking, cycling, and using sustainable transportation. By embracing this vision, cities can not only reduce their environmental impact but also create more livable, people-centered spaces that foster a sense of community and a higher quality of life for all. While challenges remain, the movement toward car-free urban environments is an important step in the right direction.

Captain America Brave New World

Captain America: Brave New World" is a highly processed, empty calorie, regret-later candy of a movie.

We're nearing the end of Phase Five of the Marvel Cinematic Universe, with predictable and underwhelming returns. "Captain America: Brave New World" feels like it's just treading water, wasting Anthony Mackie.

The story by Rob Edwards, Malcolm Spellman and Dalan Musson gathers familiar Marvel characters and blends them into a White House conspiracy-meets-international violent face-off in the Indian Ocean.

It lifts from "The Manchurian Candidate" and "Top Gun" and even steals its title from Aldous Huxley. It cannibalizes from other Marvel movies, like the addition of a substance



called Adamantium, much like Vibranium from Wakanda. There is a Kendrick Lamar song heard at the climactic end, but it's not new.

We start with Harrison Ford as Thaddeus "Thunderbolt" Ross — taking the role over from from the late William Hurt — in his first days as U.S. president. He insists he's changed from the days when he hunted down Hulk.

He approaches Sam Wilson, the new Captain America, and proposes a strategic union between the government and Captain America. "Work with me, Sam. We'll show the world a better way forward."

This is a dangerous idea — superheroes working for the government — and Cap is warned but still agrees. "Trust me. My eyes are wide open," he reassures Danny Ramirez as his sidekick and fledgling new Falcon. (Cap's eyes may be open but yours may be slowly closing).

There is a trio of bad guys, each more powerful and overacting as the last — a delicious Giancarlo Esposito as the villain Sidewinder, Tim Blake Nelson as Samuel Sterns (a hyper-intelligent megalomaniac with his brain literally bursting out of his skull) and Red Hulk, a massive slab of angry man-meat who makes the regular Hulk look like Timothée Chalamet.

There are also some tangential characters, like Isaiah Bradley, a Korean War veteran who was a Super Soldier but spent years in prison, and the weirdly cast Shira Haas as Ruth Bat-Seraph, a slippery national security agent with a murky agenda.

Director Julius Onah does well with the action but fumbles the quieter moments and supervises editing that's the opposite of crisp, not helped by script writers who ape military language — "Negative, the package is the priority" — and grandiose sentiment — "The country is lost."

For extra credit, spot all the product placements in the movie: Cap drives a GMC truck and uses Dell computers. The president of the United States uses a Peloton. What a wasted opportunity for Cap'n Crunch.

There does emerge a theme that unites Cap and Ross, which is that both feel the need to prove themselves. Mackie's Captain America throughout the previous 2021 TV series "The Falcon and the Winter Soldier" was ambivalent about taking on the mantle of Steve Rogers, the original Sentinel of Liberty. "You wonder if you'll ever be enough," he says.

Ross says he wants to secure peace across the world but really wants to reconnect with his estranged daughter — Liv Tyler — and prove he's changed. He wants to take a walk with her to see the cherry blossoms. We would like him to ask serious questions of his agent.

Mackie, who joined the MCU more than a decade ago in 2014's "Captain America: The Winter Soldier," has been a good servant to Marvel and deserves better. One of our great actors, he can be steely and vulnerable. But he can't outrace stilted lines like "If we can't see the good in each other, we've already lost the fight." Marvel has lost more than the fight; they've lost the thread.

Bridget Jones Mad About the Boy

t is a truth universally acknowledged that at the end of any Bridget Jones movie, our heroine has triumphed.

This is not a spoiler for "Bridget Jones: Mad About the Boy." In fact, if you've seen the trailer, you'll know that Bridget (Renée Zellweger), who finally married Mark at the end of the third film, is now a widow.

We're not supposed to divulge what happens next. But remember, folks, this is a classic romantic comedy franchise. Rom-coms can be sad and deep, but they still need to be romantic.

What makes "Bridget Jones: Mad About the Boy" especially enjoyable is not that Bridget finds a way yet again to triumph over doubts and obstacles. It's that she still makes us car.

How does she do it? All I know is, I was rooting harder for her at the end of this film than I was with the others, even the original where she's kissing Mark in the snowy street in underwear and sneakers.

_There are various possible explanations. One is Zellweger herself, who has brought her character gracefully into her 50s, retaining Bridget's goofiness and deep-set optimism while reflecting life experience.

And there are subtle changes. The relationships in this latest film are more interesting.

Bridget's relationship with herself is more interesting, too — and healthier. Sure, she can swig a full bottle of Chardonnay. But the smoking is gone, and so, thank heavens, is the ridiculous weight obsession — a phenomenon that hit its nadir in the icky final line of the second film, with Bridget saying yes, you can find happiness, even if you "have a bottom the size of two bowling balls."

Nothing like that in this latest installment, directed by Michael Morris based on Helen Fielding's novel (Fielding co-wrote the script), which begins four years into Bridget's widow-hood. She's living in a lovingly cluttered home in Hampstead with her kids, Billy and Mabel.

Bridget is getting dressed for a rare night at a dinner party, awaiting the sitter. That sitter is ... Daniel Cleaver himself, back for the fourth film after missing the third, which contained his funeral. (He wasn't dead!) Hugh Grant is less adorable than in the beginning, more grizzled, still slightly creepy but more vulnerable.

At the party, all the couples want to know how Bridget is moving on. She escapes, and at a

bar later with her stalwart friend group (the gang from the previous movies), says she's done with romance.

heroine has triumphed. Of course, that will prove untrue. Bridget will meet her new love interest in the most Bridget Jones of ways: stuck awkwardly on a tree in the park.

To the rescue comes a dreamy park ranger (Leo Woodall), who also happens to see on Bridget's phone that her friends have set up a Tinder account: "Tragic Widow Seeks Sexual Awakening."

And thus, Bridget's new love interest is 29-year-old Roxster McDuff — a ridiculous name, rivaling how ridiculously sexy he is.



At the same time, Bridget has returned to work as a TV producer. Her colleagues salivate at the sight of Roxster, especially when he shows up to a party, rips off his shirt and dives into a pool to rescue a dog.

"Now THAT'S a rebrand," Bridget's friend says approvingly. But can their relationship triumph over the considerable age gap? It's a subject — older woman, younger man — that's a hot topic.

Also raised here is the question of how one moves on from deep grief to live fully again.

And there are new issues too, such as how hard it is to keep up with other parents. For example: When Bridget is asked, by her son's handsome science teacher Mr. Wallaker (Chiwetel Ejiofor), to speak to the class, he tells her the previous parentwas a Nobel winner.

No worries. The lessons of this last Bridget Jones chapter speak to how one adjusts expectations and finds the right way to live in the world.

And on that note, as old photos from Bridget's life fly by during closing credits, it's hard not to feel like she's family — and to be more than a little proud of how she found her way.

What's not to love! "Cocktail? Wine? Beer?


Which do you prefer for your welcome drink?" Brice asked me, like he asks every guest. The Lobby Bar is the first of numerous amenities. There's also a

A video camera caught the mower plowing into a mailbox along the street; the man went heels over head and stumbled away from the mower, then returned and drove off, apparently hitting multiple other mailboxes along the way. Matt Clardy, whose mailbox was among the victims, called it "absolutely disgusting" but admitted, "It's so funny. I can watch it 100 times." The man left behind a Pittsburgh Steelers hat and sunglasses at one of the scenes; police are still trying to identify him.

How Horseback Riding Can Help Autistic Children Thrive

orseback riding, referred to as equine therapy or hippotherapy, has been recognized as a beneficial activity for children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). The unique bond formed between a child and a horse, along with the physical, emotional, and social benefits of riding, can significantly improve an autistic child's life. Through structured riding lessons and therapeutic interventions, children with autism can enhance their communication, motor skills, and confidence, helping them thrive in ways traditional therapies may not always achieve. Physical Benefits of Horseback Riding
