! A concert of songs from a new musical about inventor Nikola Tesla is coming to the historic El Portal Theatre in North Hollywood for two nights only. On March 27th and 28th a live band and ten singers will take the stage at the intimate Monroe Forum at El Portal and debut 16 songs from a new work of musical theater by Billy Larkin and Ron Boustead.

Larkin on piano will be joined by keyboardist Gregg Karukas, drummer Dave Tull and bassist Ernest Tibbs. 

This is Me... Now: A Love Story

K, so maybe we're not tracking her jet travel online, or worrying whether she'll make it to a football game.

But Swift-mania aside, let's not forget that J.Lo, has been the ultimate celebrity for decades. Singer. Dancer. Rom-com actor, charismatic and charming. Social media queen, and yes, tabloid magnet. Jennifer Lopez, now 54, has been doing this pop goddess thing for a very long time.

All of which is to say that when she sings now that she and her lover — Ben Affleck — don't need to give a \$%& about how others feel, well, who are we to argue?

Which is perhaps the perfect vantage point from which to assess the 65-minute creation that is "This is Me... Now: A Love Story,"



the movie accompanying her album out Friday. Some will call it a music video — it's directed by Dave Meyers, who's done hundreds — but it's heftier than that. And if the plot feels chaotic, blending mythology, astrology, autobiography, confessional, modern romantic comedy and Old Hollywood glamour (still with us?), it is so J.Lo.

Whether that means the film is, well, good, is a matter of how you feel about Lopez. Certainly, she's brought everything to the table: her talents, her imagination and her wallet, too, self-financing when money fell through. Talk about self-belief, which is the moral of the film, if expressed rather too quickly and conveniently.

We told you there was a plot, so here goes. Lopez, though channeling her life, doesn't have a name in the film — she's billed as "Artist." But before we meet her, we begin with Puerto Rican mythology: the story of Alida and Taroo, star-crossed lovers from enemy tribes. They can't be together, so By Contributing Writer

the gods turn her into a red flower (Lopez appears in the animation as Alida), and Taroo into a hummingbird, destined to forever seek her. The Artist heard the tale as a child and decided what she wanted to be: "in love."

Now we see the modern Artist on the back of a motorcycle, riding across a beach, with a hunky man, face shielded. Then, screech — the motorcycle crashes.

The Artist's adventure with love takes us to a "Metropolis" sequence in a dystopian-looking factory, its purpose not fully clear but a great setting for dance numbers. Lopez still has it. Turns out, though, depleting oxygen and dancers in hazmat suits are all a dream. We learn this in the Artist's therapy session the next day with her shrink (rapper Fat Joe).

He asks how it's going with the new guy. Not so well — the guy's a Libra (astrology is ever-present) and, more to the point, violent, as we learn in the song "Rebound" about a toxic relationship.

Time for the Zodiac Council to weigh in. Yes, up in the stars, led by Jane Fonda. This time as Sagittarius, yes the sign, who peers down at our girl and says: "I don't get it!" Yup, agrees Libra, played by Trevor Noah — Libras and Leos are supposed to go well together. And so it goes.

This wacky celestial counterpart is a band of well-meaning friends down on Earth, those rom-com buddies who stage an intervention into her love life. Is the Artist is a sex addict? A love addict? Another addiction — to weddings, wink wink! — is explored in a big number.

It won't shock you that the Artist ultimately learns to love herself, with a return to her roots (this is Jenny From the Block). If she didn't, we wouldn't have an audacious — but fun — recreation of Gene Kelly in "Singin' in the Rain." We also wouldn't have reason to hear the triumphant songs that comprise the new album, coming more than 20 years after "This is Me ... Then," written during her first go-round with Affleck.

Famously, they broke up. Famously, they reunited. (Now-husband Affleck appears here, in a sly cameo.) We watched it all. And we'll keep watching this most durable of superstars. There will be more to come. But this is her, now.

Lisa Frankenstein By Contributing Writer

t will come as no surprise that the new movie "Lisa Frankenstein" is a real monster — stitched together from previous movies, painfully incoherent and deeply, deeply dumb.

This is a baffling display of filmmaking, what appears to be a sort of feminist take on the reanimated creature trope that has been shoehorned into a late-1980s setting, complete with New Wave songs, teased hair and brightly colored spandex. Why? Presumably to giggle at shoulder pads, hairspray and Echo and the Bunnymen.

Kathryn Newton stars as the goth-like high school misfit teen Lisa Swallows, who befriends a reanimated zombie bachelor who died in 1837. Cole Sprouse plays the corpse, who is missing body parts, uses grunts to communicate and resembles Johnny Depp from "Edward Scissorhands." Whoever suggested he'd shine deserves to be made mute.

Lisa's mother has met a grisly death and she has found herself in a new town with a new family after her dad remarries. Her stepmother (gloriously over-the-top Carla Gugino) hates her and her stepsister (Liza Soberano, hopefully not making a career-ending mistake) is a friendly cheerleader.

The arrival of a Victorian-era zombie into 1989 offers many possibilities but all the interesting ones are avoided as the filmmakers embark on a "Weird Science"-like, "My Fair Lady" reversal — cleaning him up and hiding him in her bedroom. "OK, Sparky, we've got to get you some new duds," Lisa says helpfully. Those duds include a blazer and a Violent Femmes T-shirt.

The other thing the zombie really needs is replacement body parts. "You're a dead man, not a Chrysler LeBaron," Lisa tells him in-a line that's sure to kill with Gen Z. So parts are naturally harvested from people who are deemed to have crossed the pair. They use an axe to procure an ear, some fingers and a penis. (Yes, this is a quality movie: Chrysler AND weenie jokes.)

Director Zelda Williams is simply overmatched here, unable to conjure tension, interest, connection or coherence. "Lisa Frankenstein" lurches from idiocy to whimsy to grossness to ultra-violence, obsessed along the way with grade-school toilet humor, like putting worms in fruit salads.

But the blame needs to be spread around. I mean, how many jokes can you legally try to make about vibrators and menstrual cycles in one movie? "I got to go change my pad" is one of the lines expected to trigger howls of laughter.

Written by Diablo Cody — unhappily a million miles now from "Juno" — who has



tried, if we use the best possible motive, to write a satire of '80s teen movies, but has made something unwatchable — unfunny, unclever and dull. "Weekend at Bernie's," which also dealt with a corpse, looks like a Christopher Nolan film in comparison.

Maybe, like Cody's previous stab at horror "Jennifer's Body," this will become a cult hit one day. But that at least had some fun parts. This is pure lazy storytelling, like thinking that just showing us a clip of Bob Ross painting is somehow uproariously funny.

Lisa, who by the end of the movie is dressing as Madonna circa "Desperately Seeking Susan," has embarked on a murderous rampage and is rushing to lose her virginity before it all ends. Will she find love? Will she recognize true love before it's too late? Will we have to endure more jokes at the expense of REO Speedwagon's "Can't Fight This Feeling?" Who cares?

Filmgoers will note with alarm that by the time the credits roll, the sweet, goth-inclined outcast Lisa has evolved into an unhinged, violent, self-involved, murderous monster while the zombie has gone the other way, becoming more human and compassionate. Talk about losing your way.

Crime Report

What is it about Disney World that provokes violence from park visitors? Det. Duane Danforth, 38, of the Brookline, Massachusetts, police department is now on paid administrative leave after he allegedly assaulted security staffers and cast members at Epcot theme park on Jan. 30, WHDH-TV reported. Police reports say Danforth tried to access an off-limits area and said "I'm going to (expletive) kill you" while pushing a cast member away. Danforth was the 2021 Officer of the Year in Brookline, recognized for his ability to deescalate situations. He will remain on leave until an internal investigation is complete.

At an event billed as "Willy's Chocolate Experience" on Feb. 24 in Glasgow, Scotland, children and parents were so underwhelmed that police were called, The New York Times reported. The event,

which promised Willy Wonka-themed chocolate fountains, performances by Oompa Loompas and "optical marvels," turned out to offer just a few jelly beans and a nearly empty warehouse. Stuart Sinclair, who paid about \$44 per ticket to bring his kids to the show, said it amounted to "maybe 20 chairs, a couple of tables and a half-inflated bouncy castle." Jenny Fogarty, who was hired to play an Oompa Loompa, said she was given a 15-page script the night before and that "the wigs were very cheap." The organizer canceled the event on Saturday afternoon; it was unclear who had called police. The event organizer, House of Illuminati, said ticket purchases would be refunded.

-- On Feb. 19, neighbors in an apartment building in Wejherowo, Poland, became alarmed as a 19-year-old man tried to lead a full-grown horse up the stairs to his third-floor home, Radio Gdansk reported. Police were called to the building and determined that the mare, worth about \$3,800, had been stolen. She was returned to the owner, and the horse thief was charged with theft; he faces five years in prison.

-- Details have recently emerged about an incident in Willow Springs, Missouri, in November, the Springfield News-Leader reported.
