THE MEANINGS **BEHIND OUR** DREAMS?

reams have long fascinated and mystified humans. From ancient civilizations to modern psychology, people have sought to understand the meaning behind the images, emotions, and narratives that play out in our minds while we sleep. But what do dreams really mean? Are they merely random firings of neurons, or do they hold deeper significance? The Science of Dreams

exact meaning of specific dreams remains elusive. Scientists agree, that the content of our dreams often reflects the thoughts, experiences, and emotions we encounter during our waking life. **Psychological Perspectives on Dream Meaning**

Sigmund Freud is one of the most well-known figures associated with dream interpretation. Freud theorized that dreams represent unconscious desires, thoughts, and unresolved conflicts. A Complete Unknown" lives up to its title. You are hardly closer to understanding the soul of Bob Dylan after watching this look at America's enigmatic troubadour.

Mangold — who directed and co-wrote the screenplay with Jay Cocks — doesn't do a cradle-to-the-near-grave treatment. He concentrates on the few years between when Dylan arrived in New York in 1961 and when he blew the doors off the Newport Folk Festival in 1965 by adding a Fender Stratocaster.



That means we never learn anything about Dylan before he arrives in Manhattan's Greenwich Village. And Dylan being Dylan, we just get scraps after that.

The world spins around him, this uber-cypher of American song. Women fall in love with him, musicians seek his orbit, fans demand his autograph, record executives fight over his signature. The Cuban Missile Crisis melds into the Kennedy assassination and the March on Washington. What does Dylan make of all this? The answer is blowing in the wind.

Any sane actor would run. Not Timothée Chalamet, and "A Complete Unknown" is his most ambitious work to date, asking him not only to play insecure-within-a-sneer but also to play and sing 40 songs in Dylan's unmistakable growl, complete with blustery harmonica. The last big non-documentary attempt to understand Dylan was Todd Haynes' "I'm Not There," which split the assignment among seven actors. Chalamet does it all, moving from callow, fresh-faced songsmith to arrogant, selfish New Yorker to jaded, staggering pop star to Angry Young Man. There are moments when Chalamet looks at the world slyly. There are others when the resemblance is uncanny, but also moments when forced. You cannot deny he's got Dylan down.

The movie's title is pulled from Dylan's lyrics for "Like a Rolling Stone" and it's adapted from Elijah Wald's book "Dylan Goes Electric! Newport, Seeger, Dylan, and the Night That Split the Sixties." Dylan isn't a producer but did consult on the script.

It's not the most glowing profile, though the brilliance of the songs show Dylan's genius. Chalamet's Dylan is unfaithful, jealous and puckish.

In some ways, "A Complete Unknown" uses DNA from "I'm Not There." The best clues are the refracted light from others, like Joan Baez, Johnny Cash, Woody Guthrie, Pete Seeger and a girlfriend called Sylvie Russo, based on Dylan's ex Suze Rotolo.

Edward Norton is a hangdog Seeger hoping to harness Dylan. Monica Barbaro is a revelation as Baez, Dylan's on-again-off-again paramour. Boyd Holbrook is a sharklike, disrupting Cash. And Elle Fanning is captivating as Russo.

It's Baez and Russo who dig the deepest into trying to find who Dylan is. They don't buy his stories. "I don't know you," Russo says, calling him a "mysterious minstrel" and urging him to "Stop hiding."

There are some lovely moments, especially the morning after Baez spends the night and she wakes to him working on "Blowin' in the Wind." They spar a bit but they come together.

"A Complete Unknown" is fascinating, capturing a moment when songs had weight, when they could move the culture — even if the singer who made them was as puzzling as a rolling stone.



orror, not comedy, has been the go-to movie genre, but a movie like "One of Them Days," starring Keke Palmer and SZA, is a reminder of what we've been missing. Creepy stuff and jump scares have proved better suited for channeling our abiding contemporary dread. But the communal joys of big-screen comedy have, and always will, suit dark days as much as light ones. "One of Them Days," happens to arrive while Los Angeles, where the movie is set, has been decimated by wildfires. The Southern California skies, though, are crystal clear in "One of Them Days."

"One of Them Days," which had its premiere cancelled by the fires, is a welcome breeze for a movie landscape that has largely frozen out the comedy. There's one reason for this: Keke Palmer.

This is a buddy comedy, so it might seem unfair to single out one half. SZA, in her first feature, acquits herself well. But this is Palmer's show.

Palmer plays Dreux, a Los Angeles waitress who, when her artist roommate Alyssa (SZA) gives their rent money to an untrustworthy boyfriend, Keshawn (Joshua David Neal), goes on a madcap, day-long odyssey to raise the money before they're evicted. This premise is itself a kind of throwback. The antic spirit of F. Gary Gray's "Friday" can be felt throughout "One of Them Days."

The tone here, courtesy of director Lawrence Lamont, producer Issa Rae and screenwriter Syreeta Singleton, is amiably realistic. Aside from a few cartoonish flourishes, "One of Them Days" is grounded in a working-class reality where every step toward upward mobility for Dreux and Alyssa is knocked backward.

They live in a dilapidated apartment in the neighborhood of Baldwin Village, nicknamed thē Jungles. When they're forced to raise \$1,500 — a race complete with a ticking-clock countdown to eviction, and, as things develop, until "certain death" — Dreux is also scheduled for the biggest job interview of her life.

The satire of "One of Them Days" is directed at the feeble opportunities afforded to those striving to break out of a paycheck-to-paycheck cycle. When the roommates seek a loan, their payday center advertises a comical APR of 1,900.5%. (The

agent, who takes great pleasure in their credit scores, is memorably played by Keyla Monterroso Mejia.)

That's just one of the characters the two encounter in their journey to raise money via everything from blood donation to Air Jordans



hung on power lines. Some of the characters along the way include Katt Williams, as a homeless man who warns against predatory lending; Vanessa Bell Calloway's stripper-turned-blood-bank-worker; a new white neighbor named Bethany (Maude Apatow); and Keshawn's new hook-up (Janelle James), who proves the movie's most regular villain, despite the fearsome gangster (Amin Joseph).

Anyone familiar with Rae's "Insecure" will recognize some of the hallmarks, namely the struggles of Black women trying to get a leg up in Los Angeles while also juggling romantic interests. Here, that's Dreux's crush, Maniac (Patrick Cage), who drives a Mercedes and who she suspects is a criminal.

If all of this sounds low stakes, that's more of a pleasing feature than a bug in "One of Them Days." Filling this movie with anything more would be a mistake. That would leave less room for the interplay between Palmer and SZA.

"One of Them Days" hinges on buddy comedy, which Lamont seems to recognize. SZA's uber-cool transfers easily.

But it's a testament to Palmer's dynamism that "One of Them Days" would work no matter where their day takes them. There's freewheeling wit and ever-shifting subtlety. Only a theatrical comedy can really showcase charisma like hers. For an actress who's hustled to get to this point, "One of Them" days is perfect platform, scrappy and unstoppable.

James Domine Symphony #3 In A Major With Ray Ushikubo

he Third Symphony in A major (Mountain Scenes) by James Domine is composed of five selections extracted from his opera Luke and Sarah, specifically the Prelude, Hoedown, Prayer Meeting, Tavern Men's Dance and Train Song. The complete work is a program symphony such as Rimsky-Koraskov's Scheherazade, or Berlioz's Symphonie fantastique. Each of the successive Mountain Scenes conjures a rustic atmosphere unique unto itself, imbued with the untamed spirit of Appalachia. On a personal level it should be noted that the composer's mother's family originally comes from the Ohio River Valley of West Virginia and this symphony is to some extent a musical autobiography.

As the first of five movements that comprise the symphony, the Prelude or Daybreak depicts an early morning scene that sets the stage for the agrarian industrial conflict that is to follow.

The Hoedown is a medley of square dances is combined to exploit all the instrumental colors of a traditional barn-dance. The music is structured as a battle of the bands, each of the warring clans being represented by the banjo, fiddle, mandolin or guitar, and as the dance gains momentum, the competition becomes more intense, erupting climactically into an all-out drunken brawl.

The Prayer Meeting is based on a Civil War banjo tune, Goin' Across the Mountains, and recreates the atmosphere of a camp-meeting Gospel revival. Each successive verse is an exhortation by the Preacher for sinners to repent, answered by a penitent hymn sung by the congregation. Eventually the people work themselves into a religious frenzy, inevitably resulting in an all-out drunken brawl. The Preacher fires a gunshot into the air that has the effect of restoring order, and the music ends harmoniously in a mood of blissful peace and tranquility.

The Tavern Men's Dance is based entirely on authentic Irish folk songs and dances arranged and orchestrated in a way that is rhythmically compelling and full of bittersweet memories of the Emerald Isle, left far behind, but not forgotten.

The final movement of the symphony is the Train Song that takes place in a local tavem where railroad men, loggers, miners, farmers, mountain men (hillbillies) and bar girls congregate for the purpose of drinking, dancing and carousing. The rough nature of the setting and characters are reflected in the music, based in part on authentic old smoky mountains folk tunes. The indomitable pioneer spirit of American territorial expansion and industrial progress is represented by the railroad as the inexorable motion of a locomotive train travels onward into the future.



Ray Ushikubo Biography

Ray Ushikubo is a Japanese-American pianist and violinist who has soloed with orchestras across the nation. Ushikubo's highlights include performing Piazzolla's Four Seasons with the Los Angeles Philharmonic Orchestra, Gershwin's Rhapso-

dy in Blue with the Winston-Salem and Portland Symphony Orchestras and Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra, Ravel's Tzigane with the Dream Orchestra, Mendelssohn's Piano Concerto No. 1 and Saint-Saëns's Introduction and Rondo Capriccioso with the Pensacola Symphony Orchestra, and Sibelius's Violin Concerto with the Colburn Orchestra led by conductor Esa-Pekka Salonen.

A recipient of the prestigious Davidson Fellow Laureate Award in 2014, Ushikubo was named a Young Steinway Artist, won the 2017 Hilton Head International Piano Competition and the 2016 Aspen Piano Concerto Competition, and was a prize-winner at the 2023 Klein International String Competition. Ushikubo made his orchestral debut at the age of ten, performing Beethoven's Piano Concerto No. 1 with the Young Musicians Foundation Orchestra and conductor Teddy Abrams at the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion. Since then, Ushikubo has soloed with the orchestras of Aspen, Buffalo, Florida, Fort Collins, Hilton Head, Kansas City, Modesto, New West, Oregon, Pasadena, Reno, San Diego, and Westchester on both piano and violin - often in the same concert. Ushikubo has worked with conductors including Rodolfo Barráez, Paolo Bortolameolli, JoAnn Falletta, Norman Huynh, Laura Jackson, Jeffrey Kahane, Wes Kenney, David Lockington, Michelle Merrill, Sameer Patel, Rafael Payare, John Morris Russell, Jeff Tyzik, and Thomas Wilkins.

Ushikubo has shared the stage of Segerstrom Concert Hall with pianist Lang Lang, with whom he later reunited and appeared together on The Tonight Show with Jay Leno. Ushikubo has performed with pianist Jean-Yves Thibaudet on the international radio broadcast Radio France, and as part of the festival Musique & Vin au Clos Vougeot, where he also performed with cellist Gautier Capuçon. With the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra, Ushikubo was one of the violin soloists of Vivaldi's Concerto for Four Violins with violinists Martin Chalifour, Phillipe Quint, and Cho-Liang Lin,



and was one of the piano soloists of Bach's Concerto for Two Keyboards with pianist Jeffrey Kahane.

Ushikubo also thrives in musical settings beyond classical, having shared the stage with acclaimed

singer-songwriter Jackson Browne as part of a peace ceremony honoring victims of the Hiroshima atomic bomb, hosted by the Los Angeles Japanese American Cultural & Community Center (JACCC). In 2015, he performed as piano and violin soloist in a concert presented by Grand Performances in Los Angeles featuring traditional classical works alongside jazz pianist Alfredo Rodriguez and electronic musician Daedalus, who "remixed" and improvised around the classical works, crossing the genres of classical, electronic music, and jazz. In 2019, Ushikubo recorded an improvisation session with cellist and beatboxer Kevin Olusola, member of the Grammy award-winning group Pentatonix, on the radio program From the Top.

Born and raised in Los Angeles, California, Ushikubo double-majored and received his Bachelor's degrees at the Curtis Institute of Music, where he studied piano with Gary Graffman and Robert McDonald and violin with Shmuel Ashkenasi, Pamela Frank, and Aaron Rosand. Currently, Ushikubo double-majors at the Colburn Conservatory of Music, where he studies piano with Fabio Bidini and violin with Robert Lipsett. www.sfvsymphony.com

GENTLE YOGA POSES TO FIGHT LOWER BACK ACHES AND PAINS

ower back tension is common that affects people of all ages and activity levels. The discomfort can significantly impact

life. Gentle yoga poses can be effective in relieving this tension, promoting relaxation, and improving flexibility and strength. By focusing on gentle movements, stretching, and breathing, these yoga poses can help release tight muscles and reduce pain. **Child's Pose (Balasana)**

Seated Forward Fold (Paschimottanasana)

Seated Forward Fold is a gentle stretch that targets hamstrings and the lower back. By folding forward at the hips, you encourage the release of tightness in the lower back and lengthen the spine.



How to do it: Sit with your legs extended in front of you. Flex your feet and engage your thighs. Inhale to lengthen your spine, and as you exhale, hinge at your hips and fold forward, reaching for your feet, ankles, or shins. Keep your back long and avoid rounding your

spine. Hold for 30 seconds to a minute.



Magnus Carlsen, 34, the No. 1 chess player in the world, dropped out of the Fide World Rapid and Blitz Chess Championship in New York on Dec. 27 because he didn't want to change out of his blue jeans, Sky News reported. Officials said he had broken the dress code; Carlsen wasn't moved. "I didn't even think about it. ... They said I could (change) after the third round today. I said, 'I'll change tomorrow if that's OK' ... but they said, 'Well you have to change now.' At that point it became a matter of principle for me." Carlsen said he'd head somewhere with better weather.

A Florida family got just what they wanted for Christmas when they answered a 2:30 a.m. doorbell ring on Christmas Eve to find their missing dog. Brooke Comer, a Green Cove Springs resident whose 4-year-old German shepherd, Athena, went missing on Dec. 15, spent the ensuing nine days receiving tips from neighbors and people in nearby towns about Athena sightings, but the frustrated family would always arrive too late, NEWS10 ABC reported. After several heartbreaking near-misses and with Christmas just one day away, Comer received an early morning notification from her Ring doorbell. "I was kind of like in a daze, and the dog was barking, and as soon as I heard that ring, I looked at my phone and you could see in the video it was Athena and she was jumping at the door, ringing the doorbell," Comer said. Athena seemed no worse for the wear after her journey, but will receive a full exam (and a microchip) soon.

A shark caught in the net of a fisherman is nothing new, but when it's the first Lego shark find since a cargo ship lost its load of nearly 5 million pieces at sea 27 years ago, the news makes waves. The BBC reported on Dec. 28 that hundreds of pieces from the Tokyo Express cargo ship have been recovered this year; the ship was hit by an unexpected wave on Feb. 13, 1997, and lost 62 shipping containers some 20 miles off Land's End, England. Since then, the BBC reports that the pieces have been washing ashore in southwest England, the Channel Islands, Wales, Ireland and even the Netherlands and Norway, but the shark find in August by fisherman Richard West, 35, of Plymouth, England, was the first of the 22,200 dark gray and 29,600 light gray Lego sharks lost in the incident. "The sharks sink, which explains why so few have been found," said Tracey Williams of the Lego Lost at Sea project. "There are probably some

50,000-plus still lying on the seabed, some making their way ashore, others heading into deeper waters."

In early November, Emily James, 27, of Kansas City, Missouri, underwent a most unusual and expensive (\$17,000) body-altering surgery, the New York Post reported. The trans woman had six ribs removed from her ribcage in order to achieve a smaller waist. The recovery gave her plenty of time to think about what she wanted to do with those extra ribs -- yes, the hospital gave them to her -and her options seemed limitless: Make them into dog toys, boil them down for broth, have an "Emily barbecue." But eschewing all the cannibalistic notions, James has come up with the perfect project: "I plan on having someone make a crown and, like, incorporate my bone pieces in there," she said. "Getting my ribs removed doesn't change the fact that I'm a kind, loving trans girl. It's my money, my body and I'm going to do what I want with it." Yas queen.

A 12-year-old boy from Grand Traverse County in Michigan was charged with joy riding, operating a motor vehicle without a license, carrying a concealed weapon and possession of marijuana on Jan. 12, MLive.com reported. The boy's parents contacted the county sheriff when they realized their 2000 Chevy Blazer was missing, saying their son had taken it. They had tracked his progress south into Clare County, where deputies were alerted to be on the lookout. By the time he was stopped, he had driven more than 90 miles; officers found a 12-gauge pump-action shotgun and ammunition, along with a little weed, but said there was no indication that he planned to use the gun. He did tell deputies he was unhappy at home.

TEEN DRIVING STATISTICS: A DEEP DIVE INTO THE RISKS AND REALITIES

een driving is regarded as a milestone of independence, but it comes with risk. While driving represents freedom and maturity for young people, it also brings a significant danger to both the driver and others on the road. The combination of inexperience, developmental factors, and sometimes risky behavior makes teen drivers more susceptible to accidents. Understanding the risks, statistics, and realities of teen driving is essential for parents, educators, and policymakers. **Teen Driving Statistics: The Numbers Tell a Story**

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), car accidents are the leading cause of death for teenagers. In just one year, there were 2,500 teens, aged 16 to 19, that were killed in motor vehicle crashes, and an additional 227,000 teens were treated for injuries. These statistics reveal that teen drivers are particularly vulnerable.

The risk is especially high during the first year of driving. According to the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS), teen drivers are three times more likely to be involved in a fatal crash than adult drivers, with the highest rates of fatal accidents occurring in the first six months of driving. The risk increases during the first few months of driving without adult supervision. **The Role of Inexperience and Developmental Factors**

One of the reasons for the heightened risks with teen driving is inexperience. While teen drivers may have a basic understanding of how to operate a vehicle, their ability to anticipate and respond to unexpected road conditions, changing traffic situations, or hazardous weather is limited. Their decision-making is still developing, which means they are less able to make quick and sound judgments.

The adolescent brain, particularly the prefrontal cortex, which is responsible for reasoning, impulse control, and decision-making, is not fully developed until around the age of 25. This delay often leads teens to take more risks behind the wheel, such as speeding, driving under the influence, or failing to wear seat belts. Research shows that teenagers are more likely to engage in risky behavior due to the overactive limbic system—the part of the brain responsible for emotions and reward processing—while the prefrontal cortex is still maturing.



Factors Contributing to Teen Driving Accidents

Several factors contribute to higher incidence of accidents among teen drivers, including distractions, alcohol and drug use, and a lack of seat belt use.

Distractions: Distracted driving is a leading cause of accidents, but it is particularly dangerous for teens. According to the CDC, in one year, 39% of high school students reported texting or emailing while driving. Distractions like texting, talking on the phone, or using in-car entertainment systems take a teen's attention away from the road.

Alcohol and Drugs: Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is a significant factor in teen crashes. In 2021, nearly one in five teen drivers involved in fatal crashes had been drinking, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). Furthermore, the use of marijuana and other substances is rising among teens, and impaired driving increases the likelihood of accidents by slowing reaction times, impairing judgment, and reducing coordination.

Seat Belt Use: Despite the proven safety benefits of seat belts, teens are less likely to wear them consistently. In one year, around 43% of teen drivers and passengers who were killed in car crashes were not wearing seat belts. Seat belt use is particularly low in areas where teens are driving with passengers, especially other young passengers, which increases the risk of fatal crashes due to distracted driving or poor decision-making. The Graduated Driver Licensing (GDL) System: A Lifesaver for Teens

To address the risks associated with teen driving, many states have implemented a Graduated Driver Licensing (GDL) system. The GDL system phases in driving privileges, starting with a learner's permit, followed by a restricted intermediate license, and eventually an unrestricted full license. The goal of GDL is to limit high-risk situations,



such as driving at night or with passengers, during the early years of a teen's driving experience.

Research indicates that the GDL system has been effective in reducing teen fatalities. According to the IIHS, states with strong GDL laws have seen a 20% reduction in teen crashes compared to states without such laws. For example, many GDL programs impose curfews or limit the number of passengers a teen can carry, both of which significantly reduce the likelihood of a fatal crash. **How Parents Can Help: Education and Supervision**

Parents play a critical role in shaping safe driving habits for their teens. Research shows that teens whose parents are actively involved in their driving experience are less likely to engage in risky behaviors behind the wheel. Here are a few steps parents can take to reduce the risks:

Set Clear Expectations: Talk to teens about the dangers of distracted driving, alcohol and drug use, and speeding. Establish rules for when and how they can drive, such as curfews, limitations on passengers, and no use of phones while driving.

Model Safe Driving: Set a good example by always wearing a seat belt, obeying traffic laws, and driving without distractions. Teens are more likely to follow safety guidelines when they see their parents practicing them.

Practice Supervised Driving: Provide plenty of opportunities for supervised practice, especially during high-risk driving situations like night driving, rainy weather, or driving on highways. The more experience teens gain under safe conditions, the more confident and competent they will become as drivers.

Teen driving presents significant risks, but with the right education, supervision, and adherence to safety measures, many of these risks can be minimized. The statistics are sobering, but they also highlight the importance of focused intervention at home, in schools, and at the policy level. As we continue to educate young drivers and implement laws to curb risky driving behavior, there's hope that we can reduce the number of teen driving fatalities and ensure that the road to independence is a safe one.
